"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

.....*Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV)*

How much does it take to count as generous?

God measures our gifts with a measure different from that of the world. He is not impressed with large numbers. Rather, he measures according to (1) the giver's capacity (because he knows what we possess) and (2) the giver's attitude (because he knows the state of our hearts). Jesus spoke to this question directly when he compared the temple gifts of the rich men with the gift of the poor widow (Luke 21:1-4). By Jesus' reckoning, the widow gave more than the others because she gave all she had to live on. Her capacity was prohibitively little, but her attitude was extravagant.

Our **QUESTION OF THE WEEK** takes a look at the merits of **"Building a New Church" versus "Renovating our Existing Church"**.

Many of you have asked this question especially since there were plans at one time to build rather than renovate. Hopefully, the answer below provides you with the insights on the decisions made:

ANSWER: Whilst it is always exciting to go for new (similar to moving to a new home), we had to sit back and make some key decisions that would support and sustain the parish for years to come without putting a huge financial burden on our future generations. When the decision was made to move ahead to address the needs of our church, our Finance Committee Co-Chair, Carlo De Pellegrin met with Dave Finnegan from the Archdiocese along with a couple of representatives from our Building committee. There were some compelling discussions around the need to "build" versus "renovate" however based on the assessments and research conducted, it was confirmed that:

1. The Current Church building is a solid structure which will last many years into the future
2. Richmond Hill just does not have the Catholic demographics to support an expanded facility
3. The cost for a new church would exceed \$13 million and would not be affordable for this community
4. The maintenance costs would not be sustainable for this community. With the new plans to increase seating capacity (approximately 100) and the possibility of further increasing the capacity by 20% simply by adding an early Sunday Mass in the near future, we expect to address the future needs of the Parish for many years to come.

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

God's incredible love is totally incomprehensible. We can try to imagine it, and we can compare it to the love we experience as human beings, but the reality is that God's love is so overwhelming and unconditional, that it will never be possible for us to comprehend how great God's love is. That's why the feast we celebrate today, the Most Holy Trinity, can leave us with more questions than answers. In truth, any theologian who has tried to plumb the mystery of the Trinity, whether saints like Thomas Aquinas or Augustine, or contemporary scholars like Karl Rahner or Gerald O'Collins, may write page after page, but in the end is still left standing before the mystery. The three persons of the Trinity are represented by angelic beings seated around a four-sided table inviting the viewer to come and take a place to dine with them. When we encounter the love of God and truly experience it, this is in effect what happens to us: we are seated at the table and enveloped in God's love.
