Our new Bible Study program "The Bible and the Virgin Mary"

the New Covenant. The Ark was the sign of God's real presence
among His people. In Jesus Christ, born of Mary, God was really
present among his people in an even more direct way. Mary bore the
Word of God in flesh. The Ark held the bread from heaven, manna, a
foreshadowing of the Eucharist. Mary bore the Bread of Life, Jesus
Christ. The Ark contained the rod of Aaron. Mary bore Jesus Christ,
our High Priest. That is not a re-interpretation of the Gospel: it is a
truth made clear by the New Testament writers themselves.
