BIBLE STUDY AND PRAYER GROUP

Our Bible Study Course "The Lamb's Supper" continues on **Tuesday evenings, from 7:15 p.m. to 9:15 p.m.** in the Parish Hall. In last Tuesday's session, we looked at the importance of sacrifice as part of the Mass and our lives as a whole. We saw how the Old Testament covenants and sacrifices involving Abraham and Moses, and others, were eventually all fulfilled in Jesus sacrificing himself on the cross for our salvation. Jesus is both the High Priest and the sacrificial victim (or "Lamb"). Jesus instituted the new and eternal sacrifice and covenant, through his passion, death and resurrection, and gave us the Holy Eucharist – his real presence in the Mass, and in our lives.

In next week's session we will look at the Mass of the early Christians. We will see that the basic form of the Mass has remained the same over the course of more than 2000 years! We will also see how the Mass has evolved over time. We look forward to seeing all our participants on Tuesday evenings – God Bless You all!
