BIBLE STUDY AND PRAYER GROUP

At the Last Supper Jesus blessed bread and wine and proclaimed it to be His body and blood. Catholics throughout history have followed that example and so do we every time we participate in the Mass.

In next week's session we will look at the individual parts of the Mass in greater detail. We will see where the prayers and rituals performed in our Mass originated from in scripture and ancient tradition. We continue to pray for everyone in our Parish and our world as a whole.
