NEW MORNING MASS TIME MONDAYS AND THURSDAYS BEGINNING NOVEMBER 30, 2015

As of the First Monday of Advent, November 30th 2015, our morning Mass on Mondays and Thursdays will begin at 8:30 AM instead of 8:00 AM. After a consultation with the parishioners who attend Mass on those days, an **overwhelming majority** agree to this change in time. As a result, we will be able to welcome some students from Jean Vanier CHS to come and worship with us. Also, during the dark winter months, a later time with more daylight will increase the safety of parishioners who come to this Mass. For those who find 8:00 a.m. a more convenient time, we would like you to know that St. Mary Immaculate has an 8:00 a.m. Mass every day. Similarly, this time change will also give the opportunity for parishioners of St. Mary Immaculate to attend Mass here at our parish if that time is more convenient for them.

THE FIRST-BORN SON OF GOD

Moses is the prototype for all the people of God. The Gospel writers, especially St. Matthew, describe Jesus as a "new Moses" a new leader and king, savior and deliverer, teacher, wonderworker and suffering prophet. The story of Moses has a deeper, symbolic meaning for Catholic readers of the Bible. Moses is called by God to deliver the Israelites from their bondage in Egypt. God sends Moses to tell Pharaoh that "Israel is My son, My first-born" (Exodus 4:22; Sirach 36:11). In Exodus, God truly reveals himself to be the divine Father of Israel. He saves His children, clothes them, guides them, feeds them, protects them, teaches them, and lives with them. Israel is His first-born not His only son. God is the God of all the nations—and He wants to be a father to all the other nations, too. The Passover story is one of the Old Testament's defining dramas. But more than that it points us ahead to the defining drama of all salvation history – the sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross. Since the earliest days, the Church has understood the Crucifixion and Resurrection as "the Lord's Passover" (CCC : 557-559, 1174, 1337, 1364, 1402). The Eucharist, is the memorial of the Lord's Passover. In the Passover, Israel was spared by the blood of an unblemished sacrificial lamb painted on their door posts. It is the same with the Lord's Passover, the Cross and Resurrection. The Lamb of God dies so that the people of God might live.
