Our Bible Study Course "**The Lamb's Supper**" continues on **Tuesday evenings, from 7:15 p.m. to 9:15 p.m.** in the Parish Hall. Last Tuesday's session began in the most special way possible. We attended the Mass for All Saints Day at OLQW. We were able to worship with all in Heaven and attend the Supper of the Lamb, bringing to life descriptions of the Mass which we have read in our course study. In our study session we learned about Scott Hahn's experience at his first Mass. Then a Protestant minister, he was amazed at the close relationship between the scriptures, particularly the **Book of Revelation**, and the Mass. His "moment of truth" came when he saw the priest raise up the host during the consecration, at which point he immediately recognized Jesus' real presence in the Holy Eucharist.

In next week's session we will look at the importance of sacrifice as part of the Mass and our lives as a whole. We see how the Old Testament covenants and sacrifices involving Abraham and Moses, and others, were eventually all fulfilled in Jesus sacrificing himself on the cross for our salvation. Jesus instituted the new and eternal sacrifice and covenant, which we celebrate in the Mass. We look forward to seeing all our participants on Tuesday evenings – God Bless You all!
