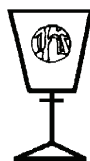

BIBLE STUDY AND PRAYER GROUP

Our new Bible Study Course "**The Lamb's Supper**" takes place on Tuesday evenings, from 7:15 p.m. to 9:15 p.m. in the Parish Hall. In our two introductory sessions we learned about the amazing conversion of Scott Hahn, the author of this course, who was formerly a devout Protestant and skeptic of Catholicism, and is now one of the most devout, knowledgeable and respected Catholics you will ever meet. We were then introduced to the concept of covenants. We learned about the great love and faithfulness which God has shown to His people through the course of history, through the covenants He made with Adam, Noah, Abraham, Moses and David. These five Old Testament covenants culminated in the new and everlasting covenant which Jesus made manifest through His passion, death and resurrection, and the institution of the Holy Eucharist which is the core element of our Holy Mass.

In next week's session we are introduced to three key components of our current study: The Mass, The End Times and The Book of Revelation. We will also discuss our own personal experiences and interpretations of these three elements. We look forward to seeing all our participants on Tuesday evenings – God Bless You!
