BIBLE STUDY AND PRAYER GROUP

Our Bible Study Course "The Lamb's Supper" continues on -Tuesday evenings, from 7:15 p.m. to 9:15 p.m. in the Parish Hall. In last week's session we studied two different experiences of the Mass, from Fr. Benedict Groeschel and Dr. Scott Hahn, the author of this Check this out on our Parish App. You can download it from course. Fr. It has led him to share the interpretation of Pope St. John Paul II that the Mass is Heaven on Earth. Dr. Hahn reminds us that we are in heaven every time we attend Mass.

We are celebrating our Mass on Earth with the angels and saints who are celebrating their Mass in Heaven. It is Christ's real presence in the Eucharist that unifies Heaven and Earth in the Mass.

In next week's session we will look in detail at Scott Hahn's experience at his very first Mass. We will see how the scriptures become alive in the Mass, and how this encounter is indeed heavenly. We look forward to seeing all our participants on Tuesday evenings – God Bless You all!
