**What is happening with the Building Fund?**

*The monthly Building Fund (blue) envelopes will be discontinued for the duration of the Campaign (5 Years). You may continue to use the Building Fund envelopes until you have received your packages and then we expect you will evaluate your contribution and respond on the cards provided in the Campaign materials. If for any reason you wish to continue your Building Fund contribution in the same manner, i.e. not pledge the amount, the funds received will be placed in the campaign account. For the 5 year period, the envelopes will be available with Capital Campaign labels placed on the envelopes to eliminate confusion.*

At the most recent meeting of the Building Committee final internal storm system drawings were approved for presentation to the Town of Richmond Hill. It is expected that because of the nature of the work and our good relationship with the Town that the approval process will be very quick and that the tendering of the work will be done mid-October, with a closing of about 7/10 days and work to be done early November. The work will allow for drainage of the parking lot as well as connection of the roof top drains and the new sump pump recently installed in the basement.

The Building Committee also approved a proposal to replace the old church bell system with a new state of the art electronic system that will most likely be in place by Advent! The system is being replaced at a fraction of the cost that a proposed repair was priced at a couple of years ago!

The architect has been asked to prepare specs for renovation of the first floor washroom and the lower lever wash rooms. There will be barrier free access on both levels. Both locations are expected to be done before Christmas.

Drawings and specs are being completed for the elevator and the new stair case in the south west corner of the existing narthex. The Building Committee expects this work to be started in January and completed before Easter.

So that there will not be interruption of access to the Church hall during the Christmas season, the renovations to this area, other than the washrooms, is being delayed to after Christmas.
