Our new journey of Truth and Reconciliation begins...



On Thursday, September 30, Canada observed the first **National Day for Truth and Reconciliation**. This day will, from now on, remind us of the painful legacy and impacts of the residential school system, particularly in light of the discoveries of unmarked grave sites at former residential school locations this year. It's a time to advance our reconciliation efforts to build a better future for everyone in our country. Reconciliation is the process of healing relationships between Indigenous and non-Indigenous Canadians, which requires public truth sharing, apology and commemoration that acknowledges and redresses past harms.

The Catholic Bishops of Canada, gathered in Plenary last week, and issued a public and unequivocal apology to the Indigenous Peoples of this land. They acknowledged the suffering experienced in Canada's Indian Residential Schools, and the role of many Catholic religious communities and dioceses who participated in this system. They recognized that this led to the suppression of Indigenous languages, culture and spirituality, failing to respect the rich history, traditions and wisdom of Indigenous Peoples. They also acknowledged the grave abuses committed by some members of our Catholic community; physical, psychological, emotional, spiritual, cultural, and sexual, and the historical and ongoing trauma and the legacy of suffering and challenges faced by Indigenous Peoples that continue to this day. As a tangible expression of their commitment to walk with the Indigenous Peoples of this land along the pathway of hope, the Bishops of Canada are making a nation-wide collective financial commitment to support healing and reconciliation initiatives for residential school survivors, their families, and their communities. With a target of \$30 million over up to five years, this will include initiatives in every region of the country to support initiatives discerned locally with Indigenous partners. OLQW Volunteers and Lay Ministers required to show proof of vaccination

Beginning on October 8, 2021, the Archdiocese of Toronto has mandated that all office staff and volunteers who are actively involved in any ministry be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. (Please note that people attending the Church as visitors or solely for worship do not need to provide proof of vaccination. Proof of vaccination is required for staff and volunteers only). In order to be considered fully vaccinated, Volunteers and Lay Ministers will need to provide proof of vaccination as issued by the Ontario Ministry of Health (in hard or soft copy). To download your vaccination receipt (proof of vaccination) from the Ministry of Health, visit: <https://covid19.ontariohealth.ca/> The Archdiocese only requires your second dose receipt.


