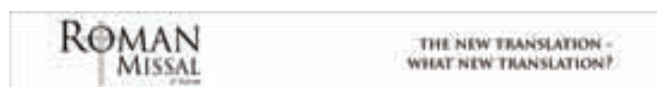
SHERWOOD PICTURES FILM “COURAGEOUS”
