Celebration of the Solemnity of St. Michael and the Conferral of the Pallium upon Most Rev. Francis Leo

The Archdiocese of Toronto celebrates the feast day of our archdiocesan patron, St. Michael, on Friday, September 29 at 5:30 p.m. at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica (65 Bond St.). All are welcome to join in this special celebration. Archbishop Francis Leo will celebrate Mass, with music from the worldrenowned St. Michael's Choir School. Apostolic Nuncio to Canada, the Most Rev. Ivan Jurkovič will confer the pallium on our archbishop, a symbol of his role as Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto and shepherd to the faithful. This will be followed by an informal reception with light refreshments. Seating for this event will be first come, first served.

Season of Creation

The annual event of the **Season of Creation** began on **September 1** (the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation) and ends on **October 4** (the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, patron saint of ecology). This year's theme is taken from Amos 5:24 that proclaims, "Let Justice and Peace Flow" and the symbol is



"A Mighty River." The Season of Creation calls the entire global Christian family to care for God's creation through prayer and action. Pope Francis published the encyclical "Laudato Si" on Care for our Common Home and called the Catholic Church to observe the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. World Day of Migrants and Refugees September 24, 2023

The theme for this year's **World Day of Migrants and Refugees** is "**Free to Choose Whether to Migrate or to Stay**." Pope Francis notes that while the decision to migrate should always be free, in many cases it is not. This was said by St. John Paul II in his message 20 years ago: "Building conditions of peace means in practice being seriously committed to safeguarding first of all the right not to emigrate, that is, the right to live in peace and dignity in one's own country." Pope Francis also referenced the words of Jesus: "I was a stranger, and you welcomed me", reminding us that Jesus' words are a reminder to "see in the migrant not simply a brother or sister in difficulty, but Christ himself, who knocks at our door."

This occasion will be marked with the celebration of Mass, on Sunday, September 24, 2023, at 12 p.m. at the Cathedral of the Transfiguration, 10350 Victoria Square Blvd. Markham. Monsignor Makarios Wehbi (presider), Bishop John Boissonneau (homilist).
