### Welcome Back Fellow Parishioners!

We hope each one of you had a wonderful summer and were able to take advantage of the beautiful sunshine and warm weather that we have been blessed with and continue to be blessed with.

For many of you, the last week would have been filled with "Back to School" shopping trips or getting your teenager ready for University. For our many volunteers at Our Lady Queen of the World parish, it is an equally exciting and busy time as we look forward to the re-launch of our Capital Campaign after a brief respite.

We do not want to lose the momentum and as we continue to line up visits, we wanted to highlight some of our key accomplishments since the launch of the campaign:

- **Many Gifts... One Journey** – a terrific team of volunteers with exceptional talents
- **Great Parishioners** – who support the campaign and ensure the well being of the church through their financial support
- **Number of visits completed or in progress** – *Our Ambassadors* are working to complete 460 visits!
- **Funds Pledged to date: \$ 411,710**

### Update from our Building Committee:

The Building Committee has been hard at work throughout the summer months and featured below are some highlights:

- The architect has been working on plans for the water drainage issues as well as alternatives for the elevator location.
- The parish has contracted for an interior weeping tile and sump pump system to be installed below the staircase at the east end of the Church leading to the basement. The work is scheduled to commence in October.
- In addition, a topographical survey of the Church property has been completed and work, in conjunction with the Town of Richmond Hill, has commenced on the layout of a drainage system for the property as well as connection to the Town storm sewers. We are also in discussions with Jean Vanier High School in regards to connecting to their drainage swale on the north side of the property.

Our Building Committee expects to meet in the next week or so to finalize plans for the elevator and let the contract for that work. We are optimistic that the elevator and new stair case to the Church hall will be completed before Easter.

The construction process may be somewhat disruptive, but the Building committee will ensure that it respects the Liturgical calendar and the needs of the Parishioners to attend at their place of worship on a regular basis.

Lastly, the building committee thanks the parishioners for their feedback to date and repeats its desire to have all express their views and concerns on an ongoing basis.

**Note:** Except for small contracts, all contracts and scope of work shall be announced for qualified parishioners to participate. Any parishioner who wishes to quote on the projects should advise the construction committee of their intent to do so.

## **BISHOPS' COLLECTION FOR THE NEEDS OF THE CHURCH IN CANADA**

The offices of the CCCC are located at 2500 Don Reid Drive, in Ottawa, where a staff of approximately 40 works in different services, supporting the pastoral work of the Bishops nationally and internationally.
