In January 2022, the Archdiocese of Toronto committed to being a major contributor toward the Catholic bishops in Canada's pledge to raise \$30 million to support Indigenous reconciliation initiatives. The Archdiocese of Toronto will contribute \$6 million in funds over five years toward the national \$30 million goal.
