

A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:

nce again this weekend, we are blessed to celebrate a Solemnity which overrides the Ordinary Time. This Sunday we celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin (August 15).

We should remember that when we celebrate a Marian Feast, the first thing is that the Feast is ultimately about God and something He did. It is also important to remember that since Mary is so connected to the Church, a Marian Feast also makes a comment about discipleship and the Church.

What God has already given to Mary is something that He desires to give to all of us. God wishes for us to be free from Original Sin at our Baptism. Simply put, Original Sin is the choice given to us by God to follow Him or to follow what we want. We spend our lifetimes struggling to accept the freedom from sin that God has offered us.

Looking at Mary and listening to the beautiful words of the Magnificat, we witness a life without sin. Mary was not a shy, quiet young girl; many will look at her in this way. Rather, she was a strong woman. Only a person completely in touch with who she is, and completely comfortable with that knowledge, can so freely see herself as only a 'lowly servant'. Mary was much more than this. She was not worried about what she wanted over what God wanted, she could easily and comfortably see her whole life as being that of a servant to God.

On this Solemnity, we should not only know Mary, but also learn from her. We too have been freed from death. We should want nothing but what God has to offer. Our truest call is the call to serve as Mary did.




