

A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:

s we continue with the 'Bread of Life Discourse' from the Gospel of St. John, we are challenged by a word relating to our relationship with God in our lives. That word is trust.

In the first Reading of the Gospel, we are introduced to people who lacked the trust in God and Jesus. The Israelites had been freed from slavery under the Egyptians and obviously were overjoyed as a result. Once, however; when they were in the desert, the Israelites were hungry, thirsty, and afraid for their lives. Water and food were scarce. They had no patience with the situation in which they found themselves. Despite all that God had done for them, they had no sense that He would continue to take care of them. They did not trust God. Moses and Aaron believed that God should punish the people for their lack of trust, yet God responded differently. God would respond with compassion which restored the people's trust.

In the Gospel, Jesus is asking for the same thing. He is asking for trust. Just as in the Exodus story, the people had seen miracles and signs. We learn today, that even with the feeding of five thousand, there was still no faith, no trust. The people wanted yet another sign.

What we can observe with both sets of people in these stories is that the people did not have to do anything. They did not have to work for their freedom or for their bread, it was simply given. The people in John's Gospel could not realize what Jesus was offering to them. They could only think of their 'stomachs'. They could not make the jump form their self-centred expectations of God to a realization of the expectations that God could offer to them.

The challenge for us is whether we can come to a trust of Jesus offering Himself as Bread. If our in our Faith we cannot see God acting in the past, how can we trust that He still acts in our lives today?

When we forget what God has done and lose our trust, we should look to where our 'Bread of Life' is kept, the Tabernacle. If we can focus on this, then we can remember to start trusting again.


