

#### A Word From Our Pastor:

his upcoming Saturday, August 15<sup>th</sup>, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

When we think of the date August 15th, we usually think that the summer is coming to an end and that the children are preparing to go back to school. Farmers are harvesting their products, making the most of the warm weather. This year, of course, is different from any previous summer. There are legitimate concerns about children returning to school and how it will be different for them. Farmers have had to change their harvesting practices. Most farmers' markets, which are a summer staple for many people, have just been re-opened these last few weeks. Still, we can identify harvest time with the Assumption because Mary is the first of the great harvest by her Blessed Son. Where Mary has gone, we hope to follow.

This Solemnity gives us the belief that Mary, uncorrupted in life, remained uncorrupted in death. As a consequence of her holy life of humble service, she was 'assumed' which means taken bodily into Heaven. We really have no details about Mary's death, but the belief of the early Christians is that she was taken up into heaven. Through the grace of Baptism, we ourselves have the hope of heaven, and we believe that our bodies will be raised at the end of time.

We celebrate Mary's Glorious Assumption on this day, but we can look at the image of Elizabeth in our Gospel passage of today to see how we can use the grace of our Baptism. Specifically, Elizabeth does what all of us should do, and that is to recognize the presence of God in other people. Elizabeth's recognition of a divine presence within Mary is an acclamation of Faith that helps point us to the Lord.

On this special day, we honour Mary because it is a Feast Day which proclaims for us the Good News of Salvation. We can point others in the direction of Christ, who lives within them.


