A Word From Our Pastor:

s we come to the end of the year and have celebrated Christmas Day we find ourselves in the middle of what is known as the 'Octave of Christmas'. Octave means perfection and it represents the eight days between Christmas Day and New Year's Day. During these eight days we are blessed to celebrate several Solemnities and Feast Days. Of course, we celebrate Christmas Day, the incarnation, when God became Man and walked among us. The Feast of the Holy Family which falls on the Sunday between Christmas and New Year's Day reminds us to be inspired and encouraged by the Holy Family; Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. We consider the strengths of the Holy Family and ask them to continue to pray for us as we live our lives, not only with our immediate families, but also with our Faith family.

We also celebrate the Feast of St. John the Apostle and Evangelist (December 27). The one Apostle who was not martyred, John gave us the Fourth Gospel which is totally different in both word and in scope from the other three Gospels. We may look upon the Fourth Gospel as the Foundation of Christ's Spirituality and a life lived in union with Jesus in the mystery of grace.

Finally, we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God on January 1st. During the past Advent Season, we celebrated the Image of the Blessed Mother in the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception (December 8) and the Feast of Our Lady of Guadeloupe (December 12). For the individual Christian, the fact that Mary, a human being, is the Mother of the Son of God is the clearest possible link between the human and the Divine. The two are united through Mary who gave us the perfect reflection of true and eternal love.




