

A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:

his is the last weekend of six in which we read from the Gospel of Mark. The next number of weeks we will be reading from the Bread of Life Discourse in the Gospel of St John.

With restrictions being lifted, people are hoping and planning to get away and enjoy the summer weather. Most want to get away and relax. In our Gospel, Jesus is offering the same opportunity to His Apostles. They have returned from their first experience in missionary work. They are excited about their journey, but they are tired and in need of a rest. Christ knows how they feel, so He takes them off to a quiet place where they can relax and spend some time in prayer. When their plans go awry because of the crowd following them and arriving ahead of them, it would have been easy for Jesus to turn His back on the crowd and dismiss them. He did not do this because He knew the state that they were in. He was alert to their needs. The people who were following Jesus were in need. Some were ill. Some had family members who were ill. Some were desperately poor. Others were simply curious about Jesus, but they all needed something. What one must learn from this Gospel passage is that Jesus did not come to do miracles, He came to teach.

What He taught the Apostles and in turn teaches us, is the importance of finding a quiet spot in our lives where we can be alone with Christ in prayer. Like Christ, we need to get away at times. We need a break from the constant calls upon us and from the pressures that bear down on us. We need a chance to listen to the healing voice of God and thereby refresh ourselves spiritually. God's voice is heard best in moments of stillness. Silent prayer, alone with God, is one of our greatest needs.

If it were the primary mission of Jesus to teach us about God and His presence in our lives, then we must allow ourselves to be teachable.

This Gospel shows us that our lives are sacred, but we will never understand this unless we accept our Lord's loving invitation to come apart and rest awhile.


