

A Word From Our Pastor:

t is once again a joy to be writing bulletin inserts for our Parish. Hopefully, we will not be interrupted again as we move on as a Parish.

The Gospel of this Sunday from Mark is very timely for us as a world, a country, and as a Church. Jesus accepts the request from the synagogue official to cure and heal his daughter who is sick. The word 'healing' is a word which has been bandied about these last few weeks within the Church and in our society. What type of healing should we be striving for at this time? May look upon healing as being a sign of control over others or looking to seek truths in certain matters. As Christians, we would be seeking out a sense of healing based on Christ. In His lifetime He went around the whole of Galilee curing whatever illness or infirmity was among the people and filling them with the life-giving presence of God. The healing acts of Jesus were themselves a message, that He had come to set people free.

We are called to see healing in this way; not to destroy or divide but to frankly heal. How can we achieve this? First, we have a call to represent God through Christ-like actions. No one can be excused from caring because we have a vocation to be healers. We may not be able to heal or cure people as Jesus did with the little girl in the Gospel, but we can show people that the love of God is made real for them, through the actual experience of care and concern shown by those around them. Just by being there, even though we are powerless, through our compassion, we can make faith in God real for others.

None of us can change history, either the world's or our own, but we can be reminded of the generosity of Our Lord, Who reached out to heal.






