SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday, April 11th, St. Stanislaus, Bishop, Martyr.

St. Stanislaus was born near Krakow on July 26, 1030. He was ordained a priest and was appointed preacher and archdeacon to the Bishop of Krakow, where his eloquence and example brought about real conversion in many of his penitents. He became Bishop of Krakow in 1072. He is remembered for his vigorous opposition to the evils of the rule of King Boleslaus II. St. Stanislaus died in the hands of the enraged King Boleslaus II.

Saturday, April 16th, St. Bernadette Soubirous, Religious.

St. Bernadette was born in Lourdes, France on January 7, 1844. She lived her whole life in poor health. In 1858, Our Lady of Lourdes appeared to her and identified herself as the Immaculate Conception. She died at the age of 35 on April 16, 1879 while praying the rosary. Her body was found to be incorrupt and is now housed in a glass reliquary in the Chapel of Saint Gidard at the Sisters of Charity in Nevers.

U. von Balthasar, *Luce della parola* p. 295).
