## THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

Dear Brothers and Sisters, the Gospel of this Sunday, the Third of Easter is the famous account of the disciples of Emmaus (cf. Lk 24: 13-35). It tells the tale of two followers of Christ who, on the day after the Sabbath and the third day after his death, were leaving Jerusalem sad and dejected, bound for a village that was not far off called, precisely, Emmaus. They were joined on their way by the Risen Jesus but did not recognize Him. Realizing that they were downhearted, He explained, drawing on the Scriptures, that the Messiah had to suffer and die in order to enter into His glory. Then entering the house with them, He sat down to eat, blessed the bread and broke it; and at that instant they recognized Him but He vanished from their sight, leaving them marvelling before that broken bread, a new sign of His presence. And they both immediately headed back to Jerusalem to tell the other disciples of the event.

The locality of Emmaus has not been identified with certainty. There are various hypotheses and this one is not without an evocativeness of its own for it allows us to think that Emmaus actually represents every place: the road that leads there is the road every Christian, every person, takes. The Risen Jesus makes Himself our travelling companion as we go on our way, to rekindle the warmth of faith and hope in our hearts and to break the bread of eternal life. In the disciples' conversation with the unknown wayfarer the words the evangelist Luke puts in the mouth of one of them are striking: "We had hoped..." (Lk 24: 21). This verb in the past tense tells all: we believed, we followed, we hoped..., but now everything is over. Even Jesus of Nazareth, who had shown Himself in His words and actions to be a powerful prophet, has failed, and we are left disappointed. This drama of the disciples of Emmaus appears like a reflection of the situation of many Christians of our time: it seems that the hope of faith has failed. Faith itself enters a crisis because of negative experiences that make us feel abandoned and betrayed even by the Lord. But this road to Emmaus on which we walk can become the way of a purification and maturation of our belief in God. Also today we can enter into dialogue with Jesus, listening to His Word. Today too He breaks bread for us and gives Himself as our Bread. And so the meeting with the Risen Christ that is possible even today gives us a deeper and more authentic faith tempered, so to speak, by the fire of the Paschal Event; a faith that is robust because it is nourished not by human ideas but by the Word of God and by His Real Presence in the Eucharist.

This marvellous Gospel text already contains the structure of Holy Mass: in the first part, listening to the Word through the Sacred Scriptures; in the second part, the Eucharistic liturgy and communion with Christ present in the Sacrament of His Body and His Blood. In nourishing herself at this two-fold table, the Church is constantly built up and renewed from day to day in faith, hope and charity. Through the intercession of Mary Most Holy, let us pray that in reliving the experience of the disciples of Emmaus

every Christian and every community may rediscover the grace of the transforming encounter with the Risen Lord.

#### **22 aprile 2012- 3<sup>a</sup> di Pasqua**

"Se uno legge le Scritture con intendimento, vi troverà una parola concernente il Cristo e la prefigurazione della vocazione nuova. Questo è infatti *il tesoro nascosto nel campo* (Mt 13,44) ovvero nel mondo, poiché *il campo è il mondo* (Mt 13,38). Tesoro nascosto nelle Scritture, poiché era significato in figure e in parabole che, dal punto di vista umano, non potevano essere comprese prima del compimento delle profezie, cioè prima della venuta di Cristo. Oggi la Legge, letta dai cristiani, è quel tesoro un tempo nascosto nel campo, ma che la croce di Cristo rivela e spiega: essa arricchisce l'intelligenza degli uomini; mostra la sapienza di Dio, rendendo manifesti i suoi disegni di salvezza verso gli uomini; prefigura il regno di Cristo e annuncia l'eredità della santa Gerusalemme; predice che l'uomo che ama Dio progredirà fino a vedere Dio e udire la sua parola, e per l'ascolto di tale parola sarà glorificato, al punto che gli altri uomini non potranno fissare lo sguardo sul suo volto di gloria (cfr 2 Cor 3,7). Se dunque uno legge le Scritture nel modo che abbiamo indicato – ovvero nel modo in cui il Signore le ha spiegate ai discepoli dopo la sua risurrezione, provando loro, attraverso le Scritture, come *era necessario che Cristo soffrisse ed entrasse così nella sua gloria* – sarà un discepolo perfetto, *simile a un padrone di casa che trae dal suo tesoro cose nuove e cose antiche* (Mt 13,52) (Ireneo, *Contro le eresie*, IV,26)."

Di fronte allo sconvolgimento e alla paura dei discepoli che avevano appena ricevuto la testimonianza dei due giunti da Emmaus, Gesù dice: "Toccatemi e osservatemi, un fantasma non ha carne e ossa come vedete che io ho". Viene alla mente quello che Adamo dice a proposito di Eva, cioè "questa volta essa è carne dalla mia carne e osso dalle mie ossa". Allora chi è che ci rassicura in ordine alla sua presenza come Risorto? Colui che indica la sua presenza come Risorto è lo Sposo, lo Sposo della chiesa. È lui che è fatto per comunicarsi a noi. Ed entra in comunione con noi in quella dimensione più propria dell'uomo che è indicata dalla carne e dalle ossa. Certo, la carne indica ciò che è propriamente umano, anche la sua debolezza, la debolezza che il Cristo ha assunto in sé. Le ossa dicono sostanzialmente quella dimensione che è la dimensione della sofferenza.
