CHRIST IS THE WAY TO THE LIGHT, THE TRUTH AND THE LIFE

The Lord tells us: *I Am the light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.* In these few words He gives a command and makes a promise. Let us do what He commands so that we may not blush to covet what He promises and to hear Him say on the day of judgement: "I laid down certain conditions for obtaining My promises. Have you fulfilled them?" If you say: "What did You command, Lord our God?" He will tell you: "I commanded you to follow Me. You asked for advice on how to enter into life. What life, if not the life about which it is written: *With You is the fountain of life?*"

Let us do now what He commands. Let us follow in the footsteps of the Lord. Let us throw off the chains that prevent us from following Him. Who can throw off these shackles without the aid of the one addressed in these words: *You have broken my chains?* Another psalm says of Him: *The Lord frees those in chains, the Lord raises up the downcast.*

Those who have been freed and raised up follow the light. The light they follow speaks to them: *I Am the light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in darkness.* The Lord gives light to the blind. Brethren, that light shines on us now, for we have had our eyes anointed with the eye-salve of faith. His saliva was mixed with earth to anoint the man born blind. We are of Adam's stock, blind from our birth; we need Him to give us light. He mixed saliva with earth, and so it was prophesied: *Truth has sprung up from the earth.* He Himself has said: *I Am the way, the truth and the life.*

We shall be in possession of the truth when we see face to face. This is His promise to us. Who would dare to hope for something that God in His goodness did not choose to promise or bestow?

We shall see face to face. The Apostle says: *Now I know in part, now obscurely through a mirror, but then face to face.* John the Apostle says in one of his letters: *Dearly beloved, we are now children of God, and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be. We know that when He is revealed we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.* This is a great promise.

If you love Me, follow Me. "I do love you," you protest, "but how do I follow You?" If the Lord your God said to you: "I Am the truth and the life," in your desire for truth, in your love for life, you would certainly ask Him to show you the way to reach them. You would say to yourself: "Truth is a great reality, life is a great reality; if only it were possible for my soul to find them!"

THE HOLY SEASON OF LENT

The Holy Season of Lent began with its discipline of fasting and abstinence on Ash Wednesday, March 9th. Lent is the yearly celebration by the Church of her corporate conversion in Jesus Christ. Through forty days of closer attention to God's Word and of more fervent prayer, we prepare to celebrate the Paschal Mystery. In this preparation for the Solemn Feast of Easter, the faithful do penance.

The privileged forms of penance of our Church are fasting, almsgiving, prayers, works of mercy, and abstinence from meat. It is evangelical (Gospel) law that a follower of Christ must do penance. While the heart of penance is hatred for sin as an offence against God, external forms of penance are required to deepen and encourage the internal virtue.

All Fridays of the year are days of abstinence from meat but Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day. Christian fasting obtains its full meaning when we deprive ourselves of food in order to be more open to prayer, to the needs of others, and to save money to give to the poor. Current Church discipline permits one to take a main and two lesser meals which do not equal the main meal. **Mandatory fast days are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, on which days one must abstain from meat and eat only one main meal. Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence and meat may not be taken on these days. The law of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 and older; the law of fasting binds those from 18 to 59 years of age.** Parents are reminded of their duty to introduce children gradually to the understanding & practice of penance. Adult example will be the greatest influence in this matter.

"Che significa "i non vedenti vedano"? Significa che coloro che confessano di non vedere e cercano il medico, vedranno. "E i veggenti diventino ciechi", che vuol dire? Vuol dire che coloro che credono di vedere, e non cercano il medico, restano nella loro cecità (Agostino, *Comm. Vang. Giovanni*, 44,17)."

"C'è un elemento che, come un filo d'oro, raccoglie in unità tutto il racconto del miracolo. Si tratta della successione dei titoli applicati al Cristo. Attraverso questi lineamenti si ricompone il vero ritratto di Gesù. Siamo, allora, davanti alla storia della scoperta del volto di Cristo, alla vicenda di una conversione. Il primo grado di questo itinerario di fede è il riconoscimento del Cristo come *uomo* ("quell'uomo che si chiama Gesù"); a Siloe egli si presenta come *l'Inviato*, il supremo messaggero di Dio, come "colui che viene da Dio". Il cieco ormai vedente lo scopre anche come *Profeta* ma il vertice è nella scena finale, quando quel povero è prostrato nell'adorazione di Gesù come *Figlio dell'uomo*, il titolo messianico caro a Gesù, e come *Kyrios*, "Signore", cioè Dio. L'itinerario del cieco è, quindi, anche il nostro necessario viaggio spirituale condotto nella "crescita continua della conoscenza di Dio", come scriveva Paolo (G. Ravasi, *Breviario familiare*, p. 106)"
