12 agosto 2018 – 19a del tempo ordinario

“Come la carne, cioè gli uomini, potevano comprendere il Signore che dava al pane il nome di carne? Egli chiamava carne ciò che la carne non può comprendere, e tanto meno lo comprende in quanto chiama il pane carne. Per questo essi inorridirono, e dissero che era troppo, e che non era possibile. «È la mia carne - disse - per la vita del mondo». I fedeli conosceranno il corpo di Cristo, se non trascureranno di essere essi stessi il corpo di Cristo. Che divengano il corpo di Cristo, se vogliono vivere dello Spirito di Cristo. Solo il corpo di Cristo vive del suo Spirito. Cercate di capire, fratelli, quanto ho detto. Tu sei un uomo, hai lo spirito e hai il corpo. Chiamo spirito ciò che è chiamato anima, grazie alla quale l'uomo è uomo: infatti l'uomo consta di anima e di corpo. Hai dunque uno spirito invisibile, mentre il corpo è visibile. Dimmi: è il tuo spirito che vive del tuo corpo, o il tuo corpo che vive del tuo spirito? Mi rispondano coloro che vivono (e chi non può rispondere, io non so se egli vive); è il corpo che vive del mio spirito. Tu vuoi vivere dello Spirito di Cristo? Sii nel corpo di Cristo. Forse che - obietti - il mio corpo vive del tuo spirito? Il mio corpo vive del mio spirito, e il tuo del tuo. Il corpo di Cristo non può vivere se non dello Spirito di Cristo. Questo ci dice l'apostolo Paolo quando ci spiega la natura di questo pane: “*Un solo pane, un solo corpo siamo noi, anche se siamo molti*” (1Co 10,17). Oh, grande mistero d'amore! grande simbolo di unità! grande legame di carità! Chi vuol vivere, ha dove vivere, e ha di che vivere. Si avvicini, creda, entri nel corpo, e parteciperà alla vita. Non fugga la unione con gli altri membri, non sia un membro corrotto che merita di essere tagliato, non sia un membro difforme di cui il corpo debba vergognarsi, sia bello, sia composto, sia sano, si unisca al corpo e viva di Dio e per Dio: si affaticherà sulla terra, ma per regnare, dopo, in cielo. “L'offerta è la stessa, chiunque la faccia sia Pietro, sia Paolo; è la stessa che Cristo diede ai discepoli e che fanno oggi i sacerdoti. La nostra non è affatto inferiore a quella, perché non sono gli uomini a farla santa, ma il Cristo in persona che santificò la prima. Come le parole, che disse Cristo, sono le stesse che dice il sacerdote oggi; così la messa è la stessa, come il battesimo è ancora lo
