

Dear Brothers and Sisters, This Sunday's Gospel describes the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves that Jesus worked for a great throng of people who had followed Him to listen to Him and to be healed of various illnesses (cf. Mt 14:14).

As evening fell the disciples suggested to Jesus that He send the crowds away so that they might take some refreshment. But the Lord had something else in mind: "You give them something to eat" (Mt 14:16). However they had "only five loaves... and two fish". Jesus' subsequent action evokes the sacrament of the Eucharist: "He looked up to heaven, and blessed, and broke and gave the loaves to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the crowds" (Mt 14:19).

The miracle consists in the brotherly sharing of a few loaves which, entrusted to the power of God, not only sufficed for everyone but enough was left over to fill 12 baskets. The Lord asked this of the disciples so that it would be they who distributed the bread to the multitude; in this way He taught and prepared them for their future apostolic mission: in fact, they were to bring to all the nourishment of the Word of life and of the sacraments.

In this miraculous sign the incarnation of God and the work of redemption are interwoven. Jesus, in fact, "went ashore" from the boat to meet the men and women (cf. Mt 14:14). St Maximus the Confessor said that the Word of God made Himself present for our sake, by taking flesh, derived from us and conformed to us in all things save sin, in order to expose us to His teaching with words and examples suitable for us" (*Ambigua* 33: *PG* 91, 1285 C).

Here the Lord offers us an eloquent example of His compassion for people.... Christ is attentive to material needs but He wished to give more, because man always "hungers for more, he needs more" (Jesus of Nazareth, Doubleday, New York 2007, p. 267 (English translation). God's love is present in the bread of Christ; in the encounter with Him "we feed on the living God Himself, so to speak, we truly eat the 'bread from Heaven'" (ibid. p. 268).

Dear friends. "in the Eucharist Jesus also makes us witnesses of God's compassion towards all our brothers and sisters. The Eucharistic mystery thus gives rise to a service of charity towards neighbour" (Post-Synodal Apostolic Exhortation *Sacramentum Caritatis*, n. 88). St Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Society of Jesus whom the Church is commemorating today, also bore witness to this. Indeed Ignatius chose to live "finding God in all things, loving Him in all creatures" (cf. *Constitutions of the Society of Jesus*, III, 1, 26).

Let us entrust our prayers to the Virgin Mary, so that she may open our hearts to compassion for our neighbour and to fraternal sharing.

#### THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday, Aug. 4<sup>th</sup>, St. John Vianney, Priest. St. John Mary Vianney was born at Lyons, France in 1786. He was ordained a priest after many difficulties. He was made Pastor of the town of Ars and for the rest of his life served the people entrusted to him in a marvelous way by his preaching, mortifications, prayer, good works, and especially in the confessional. He died in 1859. He has recently been made Patron of all Priests by our Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI.

Tuesday, August 5<sup>th</sup>, Dedication of St. Mary Major. This basilica in Rome is the world's largest church dedicated to Our Lady as Mother of God (Theotokos).

Wednesday, Aug. 6<sup>th</sup> The Transfiguration of our Lord. Today, we celebrate a unique revelation of the Most Holy Trinity. "The Father is revealed in the voice, the Son in the man, the Spirit in the cloud."

**Friday, Aug. 8, St. Dominic, Priest.** St. Dominic was born in Spain and at an early age became a Canon Regular of St. Augustine. In 1215, he organized his companions establishing the Order of Preachers, commonly known as Dominicans. Their motto is "to contemplate and to share with others the fruits of contemplation."

Saturday, Aug. 9, St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross, Virgin, Martyr. Edith Stein was born in Breslau on 12 October 1891 on Yom Kippur, the Feast of Atonement. Being born on this day was like a foreshadowing to Edith, a future Carmelite nun. She was baptized on January 1, 1922. When Edith Stein was beatified in Cologne on 1 May 1987, the Church honoured "a daughter of Israel", as Pope John Paul II put it, who, as a Catholic during Nazi persecution, remained faithful to the crucified Lord Jesus Christ and, as a Jew, to her people in loving faithfulness."

## 18a del tempo ordinario - 3 agosto 2014

"Ogni atto compiuto dal Cristo è una gloria della Chiesa cattolica: gloria delle glorie è, però, la croce. Questo, appunto, intendeva nell'affermare: "A me non avvenga mai di menar vanto, se non nella croce di Cristo" (Ga 6,14). Suscita la nostra ammirazione, certo anche il miracolo in seguito al quale il cieco dalla nascita riacquistò, a Siloe, la vista (cf. <u>In 9,7</u>ss): ma cosa è un cieco di fronte ai ciechi di tutto il mondo? Straordinaria, e soprannaturale, la risurrezione di Lazzaro, morto già da quattro giorni (*In 11,39*). Una grazia del genere, tuttavia, è toccata ad uno soltanto: che beneficio ne avrebbero tratto quanti, nel mondo intero, erano morti per i loro peccati? (Ep 2,1). Strepitoso il fatto che cinque pani riuscirono a sfamare cinquemila persone (Mt 14,21): ma a che cosa sarebbe servito, se pensiamo a coloro che, su tutta la terra, erano tormentati dalla fame dell'ignoranza? (Am 8,11). Stupefacente, ancora, la liberazione della donna, in preda a Satana da diciotto anni (cf. *Lc 13,11*ss): che importanza avrebbe avuto, però, per tutti noi, imprigionati dalle catene dei nostri peccati? (Pr 5,22). La gloria della croce, invece, ha illuminato chi era accecato dall'ignoranza, liberando tutti coloro che erano prigionieri del peccato e portando la redenzione all'intera umanità (Cirillo di Gerusalemme, Catechesis, 13, 1-3).
