#### "I Am the Bread of Life."



The Lord addresses an invitation to us, urging us to receive Him in the sacrament of the Eucharist: "Truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you."

To respond to this invitation we must *prepare ourselves* for so great and so holy a moment. St. Paul urges us to examine our conscience: "Whoever, therefore, eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of profaning the body and blood of the Lord. Let a man examine himself, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For any one who eats and drinks without discerning the body eats and drinks judgment upon himself." Anyone conscious of a grave sin must receive the sacrament of Reconciliation before coming to Communion.

Before so great a sacrament, the faithful can only echo humbly and with ardent faith the words of the Centurion: "Domine, non sum dignus ut intres sub tectum meum, sed tantum dic verbo, et sanabitur anima mea" ("Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul will be healed."). And in the Divine Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom the faithful pray in the same spirit:

O Son of God, bring me into communion today with your mystical supper. I shall not tell your enemies the secret, nor kiss you with Judas' kiss. But like the good thief I cry, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."

To prepare for worthy reception of this sacrament, the faithful should observe the fast required in their Church. Bodily demeanor (gestures, clothing) ought to convey the respect, solemnity, and joy of this moment when Christ becomes our guest.

It is in keeping with the very meaning of the Eucharist that the faithful, if they have the required dispositions, *receive communion when* they participate in the Mass. As the Second Vatican Council says: "That more perfect form of participation in the Mass whereby the faithful, after the priest's communion, receive the Lord's Body from the same sacrifice, is warmly recommended."

The Church **obliges** the faithful to take part in the Divine Liturgy on Sundays and feast days

and, prepared by the sacrament of Reconciliation, to receive the Eucharist at least once a year, if possible during the Easter season. But the Church strongly encourages the faithful to receive the Holy Eucharist on Sundays and feast days, or more often still, even daily.

#### THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday, August 10<sup>th</sup>, St. Lawrence, Deacon, Martyr. St. Lawrence, a deacon of the Church of Rome, was martyred during the persecution of the emperor Valerian four days after the martyrdom of Pope Sixtus II and his four companions.

**Tuesday, August 11<sup>th</sup>, St. Clare, Virgin.** St. Clare was born at Assisi, Italy in 1193. She followed St. Francis in a life of poverty and became mother and foundress of an order of cloistered nuns known as Poor Clares. Like St. Francis, she led a life that was austere yet rich in works of charity and piety. She died in 1253.

Friday, August 14<sup>th</sup>, St. Maximilian Kolbe, Priest, Martyr. St. Maximilian, a Polish Conventual Franciscan, gave his life at forty seven, by voluntarily replacing a younger man, the father of a family, in the starvation bunker of Auschwitz. In his extensive missionary efforts prior to his martyrdom, he established Marian Centres in Japan and India.

Saturday, August 15th, SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF MARY INTO HEAVEN. This Solemnity reminds us of our destiny as children of God, eternal joy with God in Heaven. "Finally the Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all stain of original sin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things, so that she might be the more fully conformed to her Son, the Lord of lords and conqueror of sin and death." The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin is a singular participation in her Son's Resurrection and an anticipation of the resurrection of other Christians: In giving birth you kept your virginity; in your Dormition you did not leave the world, O Mother of God, but were joined to the source of Life. You conceived the living God and, by your prayers, will deliver our souls from death. (Catechism of the Catholic Church, #966). All are encouraged to attend the 9:00 a.m. Mass.
