The blessings of human dignity, brotherly communion and freedom – all the good fruits on earth of man's co-operation with nature in the Spirit of the Lord and according to his command – will be found again in the world to come, but purified of all stain, resplendent and transfigured, when Christ hands over to the Father an eternal and everlasting kingdom: "a kingdom of truth and life, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love and peace." On this earth the kingdom is already present in sign; when the Lord comes it will reach its completion.

THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Tuesday, August 24th, St Bartholomew, Apostle. St. Bartholomew was born at Cana. He was brought to Jesus by the Apostle Philip, and after the Ascension of our Lord he is said to have preached the Gospel in India where he was martyred.

Friday, August 27th, St. Monica. St. Monica was born at Tagaste in Africa in 331. Married to a pagan named Patricius, she gave birth to a son whom they named Augustine. She prayed and wept for his conversion. Her son would become one of the greatest thinkers of Christianity. She died in 387.

Saturday, August 28th, St. Augustine, Bishop, Doctor. St. Augustine was born at Tagaste in Africa in 354. He was a brilliant youth though unsettled and restless. His search for the truth brought him to Milan in Italy where he was baptized by St. Ambrose. Subsequently, he became a priest and finally Bishop of Hippo in Africa. He wrote extensively and bravely fought against the errors of his times. He died in 430.

Jesus, Our Eucharistic Love

Let us ask the question: What is the Eucharist? It is *God among us*. It is the Lord Jesus present in the tabernacles of our churches with His Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. It is Jesus veiled under the appearance of bread, but really and physically present in the consecrated Host, so that He dwells in our midst, works within us and for us, and is at our disposal. The Eucharistic Jesus is the true Emmanuel, the “God with us.” (Matt. 1:23)

“The faith of the Church,” Pope Pius XII teaches us, “is this: That one and identical is the *Word* of God and the Son of Mary Who suffered on the Cross, Who is present in the Eucharist, and who rules in Heaven.”

The Eucharistic Jesus is here with us as a brother, as a friend, as spouse of our souls. He wishes to enter within us to be our food for eternal life, our love, our support. He wants to make us part of his mystical Body in which He would redeem us and save us, and then take us into the kingdom of Heaven to settle us in an everlasting bliss of love.

With the Eucharist, God has truly given us everything. St. Augustine exclaimed: “Although God is all-powerful, He is unable to give more; though supremely wise, He knows not how to give more; though vastly rich, He has not more to give.”

To the Eucharist, then, we should go. To Jesus we should turn – to Jesus, Who wishes to make Himself our sin order to make us His by rendering us “godlike.” “Jesus, Food, of strong souls,” St. Gemma Galgani used to say, “strengthen me, purify my, make me godlike.” Let us receive the Eucharist with a pure and ardent heart. This is as the Saints have done. It should never be too much trouble for us to grow familiar with this unspeakable mystery. Meditation, study and reflection on the Eucharist should have an important place each day on our time-table. It will be the time of our day richest in blessings.

A proposito degli affanni che ci possono distogliere dai pensieri di vera umiltà, Gesù dice: «Cercate prima il regno di Dio e la sua giustizia, e tutte queste cose vi saranno date in aggiunta». La triste sorpresa per coloro che confidano in se stessi, nelle proprie forze, o cercano Dio solo per farne uno scudo protettivo ci viene ben descritta nel Vangelo odierno. Siamo al rendimento dei conti: «Quando il padrone di casa si alzerà e chiuderà la porta, rimasti fuori, comincerete a bussare alla porta, dicendo: Signore, aprici. Ma egli vi risponderà: Non vi conosco, non so di dove siete. Allora comincerete a dire: Abbiamo mangiato e bevuto in tua presenza e tu hai insegnato nelle nostre piazze. Ma egli dichiarerà: Vi dico che non so di dove siete. Allontanatevi da me voi tutti operatori d’iniquità! Là ci sarà pianto e stridore di denti». Auguriamoci di non sentire mai rivolte a noi queste parole. Chiediamo la vera sapienza cristiana, dono dello Spirito e accettiamo di essere o diventare piccoli per poter varcare quella porta che ci introdurrà nella beatitudine eterna.
