La fragilità della carne in sé a nulla giova, ma è solo essa che, al pari del grano di frumento, può morire e morendo può dare molto frutto (Gv 12.24). Lo dà non per virtù propria, ma grazie allo Spirito di Dio che dimostra di aver misericordia della carne riconsegnandola alla vita; come dice Pietro infatti, Gesù fu messo a morte nella carne, ma reso vivo nello spirito (1Pt 3.18). La carne, in quanto mezzo di donazione del Figlio al mondo, diviene il luogo in cui l'umana fragilità può essere rianimata dalla potenza di Dio; essa consente così a chi accoglie Cristo di vivere la propria vita nella carne essendo radicato nella fede del Figlio *che mi amò e ha consegnato se stesso per me* (Gal 2.20). La carne giova non in se stessa, ma in quanto è data per la vita del mondo, in quanto è consegnata e nel contempo tradita (P. Stefani, *Sia santificato il tuo nome* B p. 161). Ci sembra che le parole di Paolo vadano viste in un'ottica di reciprocità, in una dinamica in cui l'uomo e la donna sono alternativamente capo e corpo l'uno dell'altra, nella guida e nella sottomissione reciproche, ma specifiche della diversità. Questo per rendere piena giustizia all'essere una sola carne, dell'essere una famiglia che possa sussistere nella gioia e nel dolore. Il nodo del rapporto sponsale non è altro che quello che regola il rapporto tra Dio e l'uomo, ovvero quello del servizio. (*Gruppo O.P.G.*).

Mirabile è l'opera da lui compiuta nel mistero pasquale; egli ci ha fatti passare dalla schiavitù del peccato e della morte alla gloria di proclamarci stirpe eletta, regale sacerdozio, gente santa, popolo di sua conquista, per annunciare al mondo la tua potenza, o Padre, che dalle tenebre ci hai chiamati allo splendore della tua luce (prefazio del tempo ordinario, I).
