*Dear Brothers and Sisters,* In today's Gospel Jesus explains to His disciples that He must "go to Jerusalem and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day be raised" (Mt 16:21). Everything seems to have been turned upside down in the disciples' hearts! How could "the Christ, the Son of the living God" (v. 16) suffer unto death? The Apostle Peter rebels, he refuses to accept this route, he rebukes the Teacher saying: "God forbid, Lord! This shall never happen to You" (v. 22). The divergence between the Father's loving plan — which even went as far as the gift of the Only-Begotten Son on the Cross to save humanity — and the disciples' expectations, wishes and projects stands out clearly. And today too this contrast is repeated: when the fulfilment of one's life is geared solely to social success and to physical and financial well-being, one no longer reasons according to God but according to men (v. 23).

Thinking as the world thinks is to set God aside, not accepting His plan of love, preventing Him, as it were, from doing His wise will. For this reason Jesus says some particularly harsh words to Peter: "Get behind Me, Satan! You are a hindrance to Me" (*ibid.*). The Lord teaches that "the way of discipleship [is] the way to follow Him [walk behind Him], the Crucified. In all three Gospels He also interprets this 'following' on the way of the Cross" as "the indispensable way for man to 'lose his life', without which it is impossible for him to find" himself (*Jesus of Nazareth*, English edition, New York, p. 287). As He invited the disciples, Jesus also addresses an invitation to us: "If any man would come after Me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow Me" (Mt 16:24). A Christian follows the Lord when he accepts lovingly his own cross, which in the world's eyes seems a defeat and to "lose life" (cf. vv. 25-26), knowing that he is not carrying it alone but with Jesus, sharing his same journey of self-giving.

The Servant of God Paul VI wrote: "In a mysterious way, Christ Himself accepts death... on the Cross, in order to eradicate from man's heart the sins of self-sufficiency and to manifest to the Father a complete filial obedience" (Apostolic Exhortation *Gaudete in Domino*, 9 May 1975). By willingly accepting death, Jesus carries the cross of all human beings and becomes a source of salvation for the whole of humanity.

St Cyril of Jerusalem commented: "The glory of the Cross led those who were blind through ignorance into light, loosed all who were held fast by sin and brought redemption to the whole world of mankind" (*Catechesis Illuminandorum* XIII, 1: *de Christo crucifixo et sepulto*: PG 33, 772 B).

Dear friends, Let us entrust our prayers to the Virgin Mary ... so that each one of us may be able to

follow the Lord on the way of the cross and let ourselves be transformed by divine grace, renewing — as St Paul says in the liturgy today — our minds so that we "may prove what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect" (Rom 12:2).

### **22a del tempo ordinario – 31 agosto 2014**

“Nel Vangelo di Giovanni si legge: *“Se il chicco di grano cadendo in terra non muore, resta solo; ma se muore dà grande frutto” (In 12,24)*. Qui, trattando con maggior ricchezza di argomenti questa verità, Gesù aggiunge che non solo lui stesso deve morire, ma che pure i suoi discepoli debbono essere pronti a patire e a morire. Vi sono - egli fa capire - talmente tanti vantaggi in queste passeggiere sofferenze che sarebbe un danno e una disgrazia per voi il non voler morire; mentre sarebbe un bene e una grazia se foste disposti al supremo sacrificio. Ma ciò è reso manifesto con evidenza dalle

parole che seguono: per ora Cristo tratta solo una parte di tale verità. Notate come non mette costrizioni nelle sue parole. Non dice, ad esempio: Sia che lo vogliate, sia che non lo vogliate, è necessario che affrontiate gravi sofferenze. Dice soltanto: *“Chi vuol venire dietro a me...” (Mt 16,24)*, cioè: Io non costringo né obbligo alcuno a seguirmi, ma lascio ciascuno padrone della propria scelta; perciò dico «chi vuole». Io infatti vi invito ai beni, non vi chiamo ai mali e alle pene, né al castigo e al supplizio, perché io debba costringervi. La stessa natura di questo bene ha forza sufficiente per trascinarvi. Parlando in tal modo il Signore li attira ancor più fortemente. Chi usa violenza, invece, chi costringe con la forza, finisce spesso con l'allontanare. Al contrario, chi lascia alla volontà dell'ascoltatore la libertà di accettare o di respingere una cosa, l'attira a sé più sicuramente. Il rispetto e l'ossequio della libertà è più forte della violenza. Ecco perché Gesù dice qui: «Chi vuole». I beni che offro - egli fa intendere - sono così grandi ed eccezionali, che dovrete correre spontaneamente verso di essi. Se qualcuno vi offrisse dell'oro e vi mettesse davanti un tesoro, non userebbe certo violenza nel proporvi di accettarlo. Ebbene, se andiamo verso quei doni senza esser spinti da nessuna costrizione, tanto più spontaneamente dovremmo correre ai beni del cielo. Se, da sola, la natura di questi beni non vi convince ad accorrere per ottenerli, vuol dire che siete indegni di riceverli: e qualora li riceviate ugualmente, non sarete in grado di apprezzarne a fondo il valore. Ecco perché Cristo non costringe, ma con indulgenza ci esorta. Siccome Gesù nota che i discepoli sussurrano tra di loro, sono turbati per le sue parole, aggiunge: Non occorre agitarsi così. Se non siete convinti che quanto vi propongo, qualora si compia non solo in me, ma anche in voi, sia causa di infiniti beni, io non vi forzo, né vi costringo, ma chiamo soltanto chi vuol seguirmi. E non crediate che «seguirmi» significhi ciò che voi avete fatto sinora, accompagnandomi nelle mie peregrinazioni. È necessario che voi sopportiate molte fatiche, innumerevoli pericoli, se volete davvero venire dietro a me. Tu, o Pietro, che mi hai riconosciuto Figlio di Dio, non devi certo pretendere di ottenere la corona soltanto perché hai fatto questa professione di fede, né devi credere che essa sia sufficiente per assicurarti la salvezza, e che tu puoi vivere d'ora in avanti tranquillamente come se già avessi compiuto tutto. Io potrei sicuramente, in quanto sono Figlio di Dio, esimerti dal subire sciagure e prevenire tutti i pericoli cui sarai esposto, ma non voglio farlo nel tuo stesso interesse, perché tu possa portare qualcosa di tuo, contribuendo alla tua salvezza e procurandoti così maggior gloria. Se qualcuno di coloro che presiedono ai giochi olimpici ha un amico atleta, non vorrà certo proclamarlo vincitore solo per pura grazia e amicizia, ma piuttosto per i suoi sforzi personali: e proprio per questo motivo si comporterà così, in quanto è suo amico e gli vuol bene. Nello stesso modo agisce Cristo: quanto più ama un'anima, tanto più vuole che essa contribuisca con le sue forze alla propria gloria e non solo che l'ottenga grazie al suo aiuto.
