5 agosto 2018 – 18a del tempo ordinario

Come il legno della vite, piantato in terra, dà frutto a suo tempo, e il grano di frumento, caduto in terra e marcito, sorge molteplice per l'opera dello Spirito di Dio che tutto contiene - allo stesso modo i nostri corpi, nutriti dell'Eucaristia, deposti in terra e qui dissolti, risorgeranno a suo tempo, perché il Verbo di Dio elargirà loro la risurrezione a gloria di Dio Padre. Egli circonda dell'immortalità questo corpo mortale e dona gratuitamente l'incorruttibilità a questo corpo corruttibile, perché la virtù di Dio si mostra nella debolezza (Ireneo, *Contro le eresie* 5).

Il mondo ha tanto bisogno di Lui e Lui non parla. Gli uomini hanno tanto bisogno di Lui e Lui non si muove! L'Eucaristia è davvero il silenzio di Dio, la debolezza di Dio. Ridursi a pane, ridursi a silenzio mentre il ritmo del mondo è così chiassoso, così convulso, così possente. Si direbbe che il mondo e l'Eucaristia marcino in senso inverso. E si allontanano l'un l'altro quasi all'infinito. Occorre essere coraggiosi per non lasciarsi portare dalla marcia del mondo, occorre della fede e della volontà per andare contro corrente verso l'Eucaristia, per fermarsi, per tacere, per adorare. Ed è necessaria una fede ben pura per credere all'impotenza, alla sconfitta dell'Eucaristia, che è oggi ciò che fu ieri l'impotenza e la sconfitta del Calvario. E mi pare giunto il momento d'un incontro con Lui mai conosciuto fino ad ora, uno stare assieme come mai avevo provato, uno spandersi del suo amore come mai avevo sentito. Sì, è proprio la mia miseria che attira la sua potenza, le mie piaghe che lo chiamano urlando, il mio nulla che fa precipitare a cateratte su di me il suo Tutto. E in questo incontro fra il Tutto di Dio e il nulla dell'uomo sta la meraviglia più grande del creato. Io

sposalizio più bello perché fatto da un Amore gratuito che si dona e da un Amore gratuito che accetta. È, in fondo, tutta la verità di Dio e dell'uomo (C. Carretto, *Lettere dal deserto*, 160-61, 165-66).
