Monday, Dec. 12, Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas On Dec. 9 1531, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to an Indian convert, Juan Diego, and left with him a picture of herself impressed upon his cloak. Devotion to Mary under this title has continually increased and today, she is the Patroness of the Americas.


Tuesday, Dec. 13th, **St. Lucy, Virgin, Martyr.** St. Lucy died at Syracuse, Sicily, probably during the persecution of the Emperor Diocletian. Her cult spread throughout the Church, and her name was introduced into the Roman Canon (Eucharistic Prayer I).

Wednesday, Dec. 14th, St. John of the Cross, Priest, Religious, Doctor. St. John of the Cross was born in Spain around 1542. After a number of years as a Carmelite friar, he was persuaded by St. Teresa of Avila in 1568 to lead a reform movement among the brothers of the Order. He died in 1591. His spiritual writings are a source of great wisdom and clarity.
