Sacred Conversations

THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Are you a voice crying in the desert? It's frustrating to have a message you'd love the world to hear, and you try to shout that message into the world. But all you hear in reply are crude jokes and snide remarks. Are we just too sophisticated for the gospel, even here in 2023, when the gospel has never been more desperately needed? Or is it just that people don't read more than the headlines, and they decide from there what their position is? It must be so heartbreaking to be a great journalist, to labor for a year on a piece that sees the light of day for one news cycle, and to hear the deafening silence of your audience, clicking past your work for the next cat video.

I think about John the Baptist. I wonder if his diet of locusts and wild honey, and his scratchy garment of camel's hair, was really just to draw people's attention from whatever diversions they were enjoying and to draw them out to the desert.

I know for sure that the desert, with its stunning landscapes and fascinating insect life, wouldn't hold my attention if I could somehow get WIFI and cellphone reception. I'm sure I'd find some flashy desert video to watch instead of actually tasting and breathing the real thing. John had a message, a truth that he had found, and he was willing to make himself look ridiculous in order to get the attention of those who needed to hear it so badly. He went to Herod's dungeon because of that Truth. He died for that Truth.

And if you listen very carefully, you can hear him preaching still. What would you love to shout out to the world?


