ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST

St. John the Baptist is the Lord's immediate precursor or forerunner, sent to prepare His way. "Prophet of the Most High", John surpasses all the prophets, of whom he is the last. He inaugurates the Gospel, already from his mother's womb welcomes the coming of Christ, and rejoices in being "the friend of the bridegroom", whom he points out as "the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world". Going before Jesus "in the spirit and power of Elijah", John bears witness to Christ in his preaching, by his Baptism of conversion, and through his martyrdom.

John the Baptist is "more than a prophet." In him, the Holy Spirit concludes His speaking through the prophets. John completes the cycle of prophets begun by Elijah. He proclaims the imminence of the consolation of Israel; he is the "voice" of the Consoler who is coming. As the Spirit of truth will also do, John "came to bear witness to the light." In John's sight, the Spirit thus brings to completion the careful search of the prophets and fulfills the longing of the angels. "He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain, this is He who baptizes with the Holy Spirit. And I have seen and have borne witness that this is the Son of God.... Behold, the Lamb of God." Finally, with John the Baptist, the Holy Spirit begins the restoration to man of "the divine likeness," prefiguring what he would achieve with and in Christ. John's baptism was for repentance; baptism in water and the Spirit will be a new birth.

- Am I grateful to those who led me to my faith and who help sustain my faith?
- Do I truly live by faith, or do I let my emotions, my ideas, my feelings, or my passions predominate?
- Is God the center and main priority of my life?

Dice: *Chi ha due tuniche ne dia una a chi non ne ha; e chi ha da mangiare faccia altrettanto.* Per il fatto che la tunica ci è più necessaria del mantello, dobbiamo dire che per produrre un frutto degno di penitenza non basta dividere con i poveri soltanto cose esterne e non necessarie, ma anche quelle che sono molto necessarie, come il cibo che ci serve a vivere e la tunica che ci riveste (Gregorio Magno, *Omelia 20*).

Siamo stati battezzati nella tua morte, Signore Gesù, per esserlo anche nella tua resurrezione. Sorgente inesauribile di vita, potenza misteriosa impressa in noi come sigillo divino, la grazia dell'acqua della nuova creazione ci unisce a te nella tua Chiesa perché possiamo vivere la nostra vita alla tua sequela e compiere la volontà del Padre su ciascuno di noi. Aiutaci a camminare nella vita nuova, di cui ci hai fatto dono: e se la stanchezza ci prende e la paura blocca la generosità del cuore, se ci frena la resistenza del peccato e più forte si fa sentire il peso della morte, facci avvertire che nel battesimo siamo divenuti prigionieri di te, catturati dal tuo amore misericordioso e fedele, immersi con te nell'abbandono, ma con te risorti alla vita per edificare nella forza del tuo Spirito e nell'unità del tuo popolo il regno di Dio Padre: regno di giustizia e di pace, regno di vita e di amore, Patria desiderata e attesa della gioia, che non conosce tramonto (B. Forte, *Piccola Introduzione ai Sacramenti*, 44-45).

Egli fu annunziato da tutti i profeti, la Vergine Madre l'attese e lo portò in grembo con ineffabile amore, Giovanni proclamò la sua venuta e lo indicò presente nel mondo. Lo stesso Signore che ci invita a preparare il suo Natale ci trovi vigilanti nella preghiera, esultanti nella lode (prefazio II di Avvento).
