Christian, remember your dignity, and now that you share in God's own nature, do not return by sin to your former base condition. Bear in mind who is your head and of whose body you are a member. Do not forget that you have been rescued from the power of darkness and brought into the light of God's kingdom.

Through the sacrament of baptism you have become a temple of the Holy Spirit. Do not drive away so great a guest by evil conduct and become again a slave to the devil, for your liberty was bought by the blood of Christ.

THE HOLY FAMILY OF NAZARETH

The birth of the Child in the night of Bethlehem gave rise to the Family. Hence, the Sunday during the Octave of Christmas is the Feast of the Holy Family of Nazareth. This is the Holy Family, because shaped by birth of Him whom even His adversary was constrained one day to call "the Holy One of God" (Mark 1:24). The Holy Family, because the sanctity of Him who was born became the source of a singular sanctification, both that of the Virgin Mother and that of her Spouse, who in the eyes of mankind, as lawful consort, was considered to be the father of the child born during the census of Bethlehem.

This Family is at the same time a human family. The Church, therefore, addresses every human family through the Holy Family in the Christmas season. Sanctity impresses a unique, exceptional, irrevocable, supernatural character upon this Family. In fact, the Holy Family was truly poor. It was without a roof over its head at the moment when Jesus was born and was forced into exile. When the danger was over, it remained a Family living modestly, in poverty, through the labour of its hands.

Its circumstances were similar to those of so many other human families. It is the place where our solidarity meets up with every family, with every union of man and woman, in which a new human being is born. It takes upon itself those profound, beautiful and generally difficult problems which married and family life brings.

The Sanctuary Lamps burn for:

Monday, Dec. 26th, St. Stephen, Martyr. St. Stephen was head of the seven disciples whom the Apostles appointed deacons. He is the first Christian martyr. His death was the signal for a great Christian persecution in Jerusalem, spurred on by Saul, who had approved his death.

Tues., Dec. 27th, St. John, Apostle, Evangelist. St. John, brother of Saint James the Greater, is the *beloved disciple*. He was the only Apostle who stood beside Mary at the Cross. He is the author of 5 books of the New Testament: his Gospel, three Epistles, and Revelation of Saint John. All were composed after the ruin of Jerusalem in 70 A.D.

Wed. Dec. 28th, The Holy Innocents, Martyrs. This feast honours the male children whose slaughter by order of King Herod is recorded in the gospel of St. Matthew. We invoke the intercession of the Holy Innocents to bring an end to the evil of abortion.

Fri. Dec. 30th, Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph.

“Cari fratelli e sorelle! “Un giorno santo è spuntato per noi”. Un giorno di grande speranza: oggi è nato il Salvatore dell’umanità! La nascita di un bambino porta normalmente una luce di speranza a quanti lo attendono trepidanti. Quando nacque Gesù nella grotta di Betlemme, una “grande luce” apparve sulla terra; una grande speranza entrò nel cuore di quanti lo attendevano: “lux magna”, canta la liturgia di questo giorno di Natale. Non fu certo “grande” alla maniera di questo mondo, perché a vederla, dapprima, furono solo Maria, Giuseppe e alcuni pastori, poi i Magi, il vecchio Simeone, la profetessa Anna: coloro che Dio aveva prescelto. Eppure, nel nascondimento e nel silenzio di quella notte santa, si è accesa per ogni uomo una luce splendida e intramontabile; è venuta nel mondo la grande speranza portatrice di felicità: “il Verbo si è fatto carne e noi abbiamo visto la sua gloria” (Gv 1,14)

“Dio è luce – afferma san Giovanni – e in lui non ci sono tenebre” (1 Gv 1,5). Nel Libro della Genesi leggiamo che quando ebbe origine l’universo, “la terra era informe e deserta e le tenebre ricoprivano l’abisso”. “Dio disse: «Sia la luce!». E la luce fu” (Gn 1,2-3).
