"Veglia chi tiene aperti gli occhi dello spirito per guardare la vera luce; veglia chi conserva bene operando ciò in cui crede; veglia chi respinge da sé le tenebre del torpore e della negligenza. Per questo Paolo dice: "Vegliate, giusti, e non peccate" e aggiunge "È ormai il momento di destarci dal sonno" (cf. 1 Cor. 15,34; Rm. 13,11) (Beda il Venerabile, *In Evang. Marc.*, 4,13, 33-37)."

"Quando i discepoli gli domandarono in merito all'ultimo giorno, giustamente allora, secondo il corpo carnale il Signore disse: *Neppure il Figlio*, per insegnare che lui, come uomo, non sapeva. Infatti è proprio dell'uomo non sapere. In verità, dato che egli è il Verbo, egli stesso verrà, come giudice e come sposo: quindi sapeva quando e a che ora verrà. Come uomo, con gli uomini non seppe. Ma essendo nel Padre Verbo e sapienza, secondo la divinità sapeva ogni cosa. Così il Verbo celò a noi la fine di tutte le cose, e dato che quel giorno è incerto e viviamo nell'aspettativa di esso, noi cammineremo, tutti protesi verso quelle cose che per noi sono più importanti e dimenticando le cose secondarie (Atanasio, *Discorsi contro gli ariani*)."

"L'invocazione che sale dalla notte dei tempi è ancor oggi la nostra: "Se tu strappassi i cieli e scendessi" (Is 63, 19b). Accogliamo l'appello insistente a

vegliare, perché "non sapete quando verrà il momento" (Mc 13, 33); accogliamo la certezza che nulla mancherà a chi attende il Signore: "Egli vi confermerà fino alla fine" (1 Cor 1, 8). Vivere nella speranza, il cuore aperto a colui che viene, vegliare nella pazienza fino al ritorno del Signore, ministri di vigilanza per il mondo: i cristiani sono uomini dell'aurora. (...) Vivere in stato di Avvento significa portare dentro di sé la speranza di un frutto concepito da un Altro sul quale si riversano i motivi della nostra speranza. E allora si può anche assediare con i nostri perché quel Dio che si dichiara nostro Padre e nostro Redentore, pur lasciando apparentemente il suo popolo nell'angoscia (cf. Is 63, 17 - 64, 7). Tali domande non hanno nulla di blasfemo, non mettono in discussione la capacità divina di strappare sempre più i cieli e di far crescere nel nostro mondo i nascenti bagliori di cieli nuovi e terra nuova dove abiterà la giustizia. Di notte è bello credere alla luce (Un monaco benedettino, *Jours du Seigneur. Année liturgique 1, 60-61*)."
