ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST

St. John the Baptist is the Lord's immediate precursor or forerunner, sent to prepare His way. "Prophet of the Most High", John surpasses all the prophets, of whom he is the last. He inaugurates the Gospel, already from his mother's womb welcomes the coming of Christ, and rejoices in being "the friend of the bridegroom", whom he points out as "the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world". Going before Jesus "in the spirit and power of Elijah", John bears witness to Christ in his preaching, by his Baptism of conversion, and through his martyrdom.

John the Baptist is "more than a prophet." In him, the Holy Spirit concludes His speaking through the prophets. John completes the cycle of prophets begun by Elijah. He proclaims the imminence of the consolation of Israel; he is the "voice" of the Consoler who is coming. As the Spirit of truth will also do, John "came to bear witness to the light." In John's sight, the Spirit thus brings to completion the careful search of the prophets and fulfills the longing of the angels. "He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain, this is He who baptizes with the Holy Spirit. And I have seen and have borne witness that this is the Son of God.... Behold, the Lamb of God." Finally, with John the Baptist, the Holy Spirit begins the restoration to man of "the divine likeness," prefiguring what he would achieve with and in Christ. John's baptism was for repentance; baptism in water and the Spirit will be a new birth.

ADVENT

Advent has a twofold character. As a season to prepare us for Christmas when Christ's first coming to us is remembered: as a season when that remembrance directs the mind and heart to await Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. Advent is thus a period of devout and joyful expectation.

From December 17th on, there is a notable shift in emphasis as the events immediately preceding the Lord's birth are present in the gospel readings while the first readings proclaim the most important Messianic prophecies.

During Advent, each Sunday's gospel has a specific theme. The Old Testament readings, especially those taken from Isaiah, are prophecies about the Messiah and messianic times. The selections from the writings of the apostles present exhortations and instructions on different themes of this season.

In 374, while living in Milan, he was elected bishop of the city by popular acclaim and ordained on December 7th. He devotedly carried out his duties and was an effective pastor and teacher. He died in 397.

2^a di Avvento - 5 dicembre 2010

L'Avvento ha valore in sé e non solo in vista del Natale. Iniziare l'anno liturgico con l'Avvento significa riportarci al vero motivo per cui viviamo: l'attesa del Signore. Ed è importante pensare che prima di noi altri hanno atteso e che, nella vicenda degli altri, come Gesù indica essere per sé, noi siamo invitati a cogliere la venuta del Signore. La storia dell'umanità può essere letta come la storia di chi ha atteso il Signore. L'Avvento è un tempo opportuno per rileggere la nostra storia e intravedere 'nuovi germogli', sentire nostalgia di qualcosa che possa togliere pesantezza alla nostra esistenza. È un tempo propizio perché anche in noi germogli qualcosa di nuovo come il germoglio dal tronco di Iesse, qualcosa che dia vigore all'identità del credente e rinnovi la comunione all'interno della comunità.

"Noi abbiamo un problema. Forse un problema spicciolo: che saremo? grano o pula? Già. Non ci piacerebbe proprio essere il materiale di scarto del Signore. Strane sensazioni di rispetto e timore si mescolano: paura del ventilabro, paura del fuoco inestinguibile (Mt 3,12), paura della scure (Mt 3,10). Eppure fermarsi alla paura sarebbe una posizione troppo comoda; vedere come irraggiungibile la meta è utile solo a chi cerca scuse per non intraprendere il cammino. Certo ognuno di noi parte da quel poco che può, ma con la speranza di arrivare a compiere ciò di cui nemmeno ci si penserebbe capaci. Questi ci sembrano i "frutti degni di conversione": prendere in mano la propria vita, il proprio "punto di partenza", per lasciarsi poi guidare. La conversione è il movimento dell'uomo, la salvezza è il moto di Dio (*Gruppo OPG*)."

La spiritualità del cristiano è la spiritualità del tempo intermedio, tra la prima e la seconda venuta di Cristo. La vigilanza è la virtù di cui Gesù maggiormente ci parla; è la virtù per eccellenza. Quaggiù noi non possiamo altro che protenderci verso la carità, così come ci protendiamo verso il Cristo. Solo attraverso la vigilanza, questo incessante vegliare, noi possiamo mettere da parte nostra tutto ciò che è necessario perché da parte sua il Dio vivente, nel suo Spirito, ci metta l'Amore che ci deve totalmente colmare, totalmente riempire. La veglia è una risposta alla fedeltà di Dio. La nostra vigilanza è correlativa alla certezza che Dio è fedele. Se contiamo su questo, riusciamo, possiamo anche vegliare; d'altra parte, quello che Dio ci chiede in contrapposizione alla sua fedeltà, è precisamente che noi vegliamo, con questa tensione incessante, all'incontro con il suo Cristo. Questa vigilanza si caratterizza per tensione, per sforzo, per lotta, per tenebre: perché è virtù del tempo intermedio che è il tempo della prova. Ma la vigilanza cristiana deve essere accompagnata sempre da una punta di gioia che scaturisce da questa certezza: che Dio, in Cristo ci ha dato già tutto ciò di cui abbiamo bisogno. Il mormorare per le difficoltà non è giusto perché gli ostacoli sono molto meno dei doni che ci sono stati già fatti, le prove sono molto meno dure dei mezzi che ci sono stati già dati per vincerle. Tutta la comunità è chiamata alla vigilanza, perché l'intero popolo ha la garanzia d'incontrare il Cristo nella sua totalità. La fedeltà e la vigilanza della comunità danno la sicurezza dell'incontro personale con il Signore.
