Dear Brothers and Sisters!

Today we celebrate Second Sunday of Advent. In today's reading, we are told, "The winding roads shall be made straight." How do we make our path straight?

By following God's will wholeheartedly.

Our Father gently calls us to repent from our crooked paths & return home to him. He reaches out & offers to help us find our way directly back to him.

On March 13, during a penitential service at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, Pope Francis announced an Extraordinary Jubilee, also known as the Holy Year of Mercy, to begin on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception on December 8 (our Parish Feast) and end on the Feast of Christ the King on Nov. 20, 2016.

The Holy Father said in his homily "I am confident that the whole Church, which is in need of mercy for we are sinners, will be able to find in this Jubilee the joy of rediscovering and rendering fruitful God's mercy, with which we are all called to give comfort to every man and every woman of our time."

Pope Francis wrote in his letter on the Year of Mercy that he desired it to be "an extraordinary moment of grace and spiritual renewal." He also placed a particular emphasis on the sacrament of confession, urging all to "place the sacrament of reconciliation at the center once more," and thus rediscover "a path back to the Lord."

I really pray and hope that this Year of Mercy will help us to experience God's Love, Forgiveness and His Mercy. Advent, time of spiritual workout is a perfect time to begin making changes in our lives and experience over again how Merciful our Lord is.

I want to invite you this coming Tuesday at 7 pm for the celebration of the Holy Eucharist on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception as well as the beginning of the Year of Mercy.

Let's come together as a Parish Family to begin the Year of Mercy with Our Lady in such difficult times, looking on Divine Mercy icon in our Church and saying together 'Jesus I trust in You!'

**Monday, December 7<sup>th</sup>, St. Ambrose, Bishop, Doctor.** St. Ambrose was born at Trier about the year 340. In 374, while living in Milan, he was elected bishop of the city by popular acclaim and ordained on December 7<sup>th</sup>. He devotedly carried out his duties & was an effective pastor & teacher. He died in 397.

**Tuesday, Dec. 8, Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. In addition to our morning 8 a.m. Mass, there will be a 7 p.m. Mass.** This Feast celebrates the sinlessness and purity of the Blessed Virgin Mary. "**O Mary conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee.**" Refreshments to be served in the Parish Hall following the Mass.

**Saturday, Dec. 12, Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas** On Dec. 9 1531, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to an Indian convert, Juan Diego, and left with him a picture of herself impressed upon his cloak. Devotion to Mary under this title has continually increased and today, she is the Patroness of the Americas.

**6 dicembre 2015 – 2a di Avvento**

*Ogni montagna e ogni colle sarà abbassato.* Non sbaglierai se vedrai in queste montagne e colline abbattute le potenze nemiche che si levano contro gli uomini. *E tutte le cose tortuose diverranno diritte.* Ognuno di noi era tortuoso - se non lo è forse anche oggi - e, per la venuta di Cristo che si è compiuta anche nella nostra anima, tutto ciò che era tortuoso è diventato diritto. A che ti serve, infatti, che Cristo sia venuto un tempo nella carne, se non è venuto anche nella tua anima? Preghiamo dunque perché ogni giorno il suo avvento si compia in noi, onde possiamo dire: *Vivo, ma non più io, è Cristo che vive in me* (Gal 2,20). E niente un tempo era più aspro di te. Ma è venuto il mio Signore Gesù, ha spianato le tue asperità, ha mutato in strade diritte tutto il tuo disordine, perché in te sorgesse una strada senza inciampi, un cammino dolce e puro, lungo il quale in te Dio Padre potesse procedere, e Cristo Signore in te potesse fissare la sua dimora e dire: *Io e il Padre mio verremo e porremo in lui la nostra dimora* (Gv 14,23) (Origene, *Commento al vangelo di Luca*).

**“Altro elemento fondamentale dell’Avvento è l’attesa, attesa che è nello stesso tempo speranza. L’Avvento ci spinge a capire il senso del tempo e della storia come “kairós”, come occasione favorevole per la nostra salvezza. Gesù ha illustrato questa realtà misteriosa in molte parabole: nel racconto dei servi invitati ad attendere il ritorno del padrone; nella parabola delle vergini che aspettano lo sposo; o in quelle della semina e della mietitura. L’uomo, nella sua vita, è in costante attesa: quando è bambino vuole crescere, da adulto tende alla realizzazione e al successo, avanzando nell’età, aspira al meritato riposo. Ma arriva il tempo in cui egli scopre di aver sperato troppo poco se, al di là della professione o della posizione sociale, non gli rimane nient’altro da sperare. La speranza segna il cammino dell’umanità, ma per i cristiani essa è animata da una certezza: il Signore è presente nello scorrere della nostra vita, ci accompagna e un giorno asciugherà anche le nostre lacrime. Un giorno, non lontano, tutto troverà il suo compimento nel Regno di Dio, Regno di giustizia e di pace (Benedetto XVI).”**

La Parola di Dio è la forza liberante. Il Cristo, Verbo del Padre, è il grande liberatore e condottiero. Giovanni lo precede per preparare la partenza. Per questo la Parola di Dio “avviene” per lui. La fede è questa: quando la Parola di Dio diventa avvenimento in te e per te, quando “riconosci” il Signore riconoscendo te stesso in colui che, nella Parola, viene liberato e salvato.
