THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday, December 8, Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. In addition to our morning 8 a.m. Mass, there will be a 7 p.m. Mass. Main celebrant will be Archbishop Larry Saldanha. This Feast celebrates the sinlessness and purity of the Blessed Virgin Mary. **"O Mary conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee."**

Friday, Dec. 12, Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas On Dec. 9 1531, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to an Indian convert, Juan Diego, and left with him a picture of herself impressed upon his cloak. Devotion to Mary under this title has continually increased and today, she is the Patroness of the Americas.

Saturday, Dec. 13, St. Lucy, Virgin, Martyr. St. Lucy died at Syracuse, Sicily, probably during the persecution of the Emperor Diocletian. Her cult spread throughout the Church, and her name was introduced into the Roman Canon (Eucharistic Prayer I).

2a di Avvento – 7 dicembre 2014

“Mosè battezzò, ma nell’acqua (cfr Es 17,6); e ancor prima nella nube e nel mare (cfr Es 13,21) ... Battezzò anche Giovanni e non più alla maniera dei Giudei: infatti non battezzò solamente con l’acqua, ma anche per la conversione; tuttavia il suo battesimo non era ancora completamente spirituale, perché egli non aggiunse che battezzava ‘nello Spirito’. Battezza anche Gesù, ma nello Spirito ... Conosco anche un quarto battesimo, quello che avviene per mezzo del sangue e della testimonianza, e che fu impartito anche al Cristo stesso, ed è un battesimo molto più venerabile degli altri, in quanto non viene insozzato da altre macchie. Ne conosco anche un quinto, quello delle lacrime; ma è un battesimo più impegnativo, perché è quello che bagna ogni notte di lacrime il proprio letto e il proprio giaciglio (cfr Sal 6,7) (Gregorio di Nazianzo, *Omelie Pasquali* 39,17).”

“Troppo spesso quando portiamo un messaggio la gente vede noi e percepisce un messaggio che forse arriva attraverso noi, perché non siamo sufficientemente identificati con quello che dobbiamo dire. Per ottenere questa identificazione dobbiamo leggere il Vangelo in modo tale, renderlo così nostro e rendere noi stessi così Vangelo, che quando parliamo come dal di dentro del Vangelo stesso, in suo nome, dovrebbe essere semplicemente il Vangelo che parla – indipendentemente dalle parole usate, e non sto parlando di citazioni – e noi dovremmo essere come una voce, la voce di Dio. La seconda cosa è che per arrivare allo stadio in cui poteva parlare senza essere notato, in cui la gente aveva di lui l’impressione di un uomo trasformato completamente in un messaggio, in una visione, in una proclamazione, egli doveva essere un uomo che aveva rinunciato a ogni forma di egoismo, di accaparramento, a tutto ciò che era piacevolmente gratificante (Anthony Bloom, *Dio e l’uomo*, 126-128).”

“Ed è proprio lo Spirito Santo, che nel grembo della Vergine ha formato Gesù, Uomo perfetto, a portare a compimento nella persona umana il mirabile progetto di Dio, trasformando innanzitutto il cuore e, a partire da questo centro, tutto il resto. Avviene così che in ogni singola persona si riassume l’intera opera della creazione e della redenzione, che Dio, Padre e Figlio e Spirito Santo, va compiendo dall’inizio alla fine del cosmo e della storia.
