

THE TRANSFIGURATION

From the day Peter confessed that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God, the Master "began to show His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things... and be killed, and on the third day be raised." Peter scorns this prediction, nor do the others understand it any better than he. In this context the mysterious episode of Jesus' Transfiguration takes place on a high mountain, before three witnesses chosen by Himself: Peter, James and John. Jesus' face and clothes become dazzling with light, and Moses and Elijah appear, speaking "of His departure, which He was to accomplish at Jerusalem". A cloud covers Him and a voice from heaven says: "This is My Son, My Chosen; listen to Him!"

For a moment Jesus discloses His divine glory, confirming Peter's confession. He also reveals that He will have to go by the way of the cross at Jerusalem in order to "enter into His glory". Moses and Elijah had seen God's glory on the Mountain; the Law and the Prophets had announced the Messiah's sufferings. Christ's Passion is the will of the Father: the Son acts as God's servant; the cloud indicates the presence of the Holy Spirit. "The whole Trinity appeared: the Father in the voice; the Son in the man; the Spirit in the shining cloud."

You were transfigured on the mountain, and your disciples, as much as they were capable of it, beheld your glory, O Christ our God, so that when they should see you crucified they would understand that your Passion was voluntary, and proclaim to the world that you truly are the splendor of the Father.

2^a di Quaresima - 28 febbraio 2010

Siamo invitati a salire il monte della Trasfigurazione per riuscire a intravedere qualcosa della gloria del Signore risorto, per avere il coraggio e la forza di percorrere il cammino quaresimale con decisione, anche nei momenti di tribolazione e di sofferenza, quando il cammino conduce verso il Calvario e la croce. Il cammino della quaresima che ci viene proposto è il cammino dell'amore. Dobbiamo imparare a trasformare la nostra vita in obbedienza a Dio o – che è lo stesso – dobbiamo imparare a trasformarla in amore. Ma guai a chi si illude che la trasformazione della vita in amore sia una cosa facile o gradevole. In certi momenti è certamente gradevole: ci sono per fortuna delle consolazioni del Signore; ma la trasformazione della nostra vita in amore si chiama croce. È nel momento della croce che Gesù Cristo ha donato tutto e quindi ha trasformato tutto in amore. Questo lo dobbiamo mettere in conto; non dobbiamo lasciarci spaventare da quello che nella croce c'è di pesante, faticoso e di spaventoso per noi. L'unico modo per non essere spaventati è riuscire un poco a intravedere la gloria di Cristo, la bellezza del Signore anche dentro alla sua sofferenza.

"È bello per noi stare qui". Succede anche a me: quando leggo le Scritture e arrivo a capire spiritualmente qualcosa di grande, non voglio più distaccarmene, non ho più voglia di scendere verso cose più basse; la mia volontà è fare del mio cuore un tabernacolo per Cristo, la Legge e i Profeti. Eppure Gesù, che è venuto apposta in questo mondo per salvare ciò che era perduto, che è venuto a salvare non i santi, ma le persone in difficoltà. Gesù sa che anche se l'umanità se ne sta sul monte, non potrà salvarsi a meno che ridiscenda in basso" (Girolamo, *Omelia su Marco* 6).

"Che meraviglia che la sua faccia sia diventata come il sole, se egli è il Sole? Era il Sole, ma nascosto sotto una nube: rimossa la nube, ecco che splende. Che cos'è questa nube che viene rimossa? Non proprio la carne, ma la debolezza della carne che viene rimossa per un istante. Nube che cela lo splendore divino,leggera, sollevata anch'essa agli eterni splendori. Oggi, sebbene coperta da questa nube di carne, la luce che illumina ogni uomo ha manifestato il suo splendore, glorificando anche la sua carne e mostrandola deificata agli apostoli e, attraverso gli apostoli, a tutto il mondo (Pietro il Venerabile, Sermone 1)."


