THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Thursday, February 11th, Our Lady of Lourdes. In 1858, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to a little girl named Bernadette at Lourdes in France. Through this humble girl, our Lady called sinners to conversion and enkindled within the Church a great zeal for prayer and charity, especially service to the sick and the poor.

World Day of the Sick. The ministry of Jesus to the sick is central to the life of the Church. The memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes highlights the healing ministry of the Church. It reminds us that service to the sick and suffering cannot be neglected. It recognizes the great effort of doctors, nurses, health care institutions and pastoral care givers to restore health to those afflicted with illness and disease. There will be an opportunity for the reception of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick after Mass for those in need. As a reminder, according to the Catechism of the Catholic Church 1514-1515 The Anointing of the Sick "is not a sacrament for those only who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived." If a sick person who received this anointing recovers his health, he can in the case of another grave illness receive this ... again. If during the same illness the person's condition becomes more serious, (it) may be repeated. It is fitting to receive the Anointing of the Sick just prior to a serious operation. The same holds for the elderly whose frailty becomes more pronounced.
