Il carattere meraviglioso del miracolo può anche allontanare dal vero in esso contenuto. Per questo, in quella circostanza, Gesù proibì al lebbroso di divulgare la notizia della sua guarigione. Volle evangelizzare senza quel racconto del miracolo. La predicazione e la fede possono fare a meno dei miracoli (Agostino, *Discorsi*, 98,3)

Il peccato ci ha resi maledetti, segregati, impuri e portatori di morte come quel lebbroso e la legge ce lo dimostra e ce lo ricorda continuamente, ma oggi la Parola ci invita ad andare con quel lebbroso davanti a Gesù, inginocchiarsi ai suoi piedi e supplicarlo. Ci interessa veramente essere mondati? Allora umiliamoci e supplichiamo Cristo che, se vuole (e lo vuole!), può guarirci dal momento che ci ha riscattati dalla maledizione della legge diventando lui stesso maledizione per noi, come sta scritto: Maledetto chi pende dal legno (Gal 3,13). Confessiamo pure con verità e chiarezza il nostro peccato: Cristo non ha paura di essere contagiato da noi poiché lui, che non aveva conosciuto peccato, Dio trattò da peccato in nostro favore, perché noi potessimo diventare per mezzo di lui giustizia di Dio (2 Cor 5,21). Come, mosso a compassione per il lebbroso, Gesù stese la mano, lo toccò e gli disse: Lo voglio, guarisci, così oggi, a quanti di noi lo pregano con umiltà, sincerità e insistenza, dice le stesse parole e opera lo stesso miracolo e aggiunge lo stesso comando: Va', presentati al sacerdote, e offri per la tua purificazione quello che Mosè ha ordinato, a testimonianza per loro.

Il lebbroso con il gesto e le parole, dimostra che cosa significa credere, cioè osare in umiltà (Q. Dehn).

Gesù si muove a compassione... Significa: "Sono disposto a prendere un po' della tua lebbra, a condividere la tua sorte, a vivere la tua emarginazione e la tua morte. Questo lo faccio perché penso che la sofferenza, vissuta nella condivisione, pesa di meno. Se siamo in due, non sei più solo" (Paul Devreux).

Se vuoi, puoi guarirmi. Non merito nulla, ho solo fame di pietà e di persone (Ermes Ronchi).
