**MESSAGE OF HIS HOLINESS
POPE BENEDICT XVI FOR LENT 2012**

“Let us be concerned for each other, to stir a response in love and good works” (Heb 10:24)

Dear Brothers and Sisters, The Lenten season offers us once again an opportunity to reflect upon the very heart of Christian life: charity. This is a favourable time to renew our journey of faith, both as individuals and as a community, with the help of the word of God and the sacraments. This journey is one marked by prayer and sharing, silence and fasting, in anticipation of the joy of Easter.

This year I would like to propose a few thoughts in the light of a brief biblical passage drawn from the *Letter to the Hebrews*: “Let us be concerned for each other, to stir a response in love and good works”. These words are part of a passage in which the sacred author exhorts us to trust in Jesus Christ as the High Priest who has won us forgiveness and opened up a pathway to God. Embracing Christ bears fruit in a life structured by the three theological virtues: it means approaching the Lord “sincere in heart and filled with *faith*” (v. 22), keeping firm “in the *hope* we profess” (v. 23) and ever mindful of living a life of “*love and good works*” (v. 24) together with our brothers and sisters. The author states that to sustain this life shaped by the Gospel it is important to participate in the liturgy and community prayer, mindful of the eschatological goal of full communion in God (v. 25). Here I would like to reflect on verse 24, which offers a succinct, valuable and ever timely teaching on the three aspects of Christian life: concern for others, reciprocity and personal holiness....

In a world which demands of Christians a renewed witness of love and fidelity to the Lord, may all of us feel the urgent need to anticipate one another in charity, service and good works (cf. Heb 6:10). This appeal is particularly pressing in this holy season of preparation for Easter. As I offer my prayerful good wishes for a blessed and fruitful Lenten period, I entrust all of you to the intercession of the Mary Ever Virgin and cordially impart my Apostolic Blessing.

THE HOLY SEASON OF LENT

Lent is the yearly celebration by the Church of her corporate conversion in Jesus Christ. Through forty days of closer attention to God’s Word and of more fervent prayer, we prepare to celebrate the Paschal Mystery. In this preparation for the Solemn Feast of Easter, the faithful do penance.

The privileged forms of penance of our Church are fasting, almsgiving, prayers, works of mercy, and abstinence from meat. It is evangelical (Gospel) law that a follower of Christ must do penance. While the heart of penance is hatred for sin as an offence against God, external forms of penance are required to deepen and encourage the internal virtue.

All Fridays of the year are days of abstinence from meat but Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day. Christian fasting obtains its full meaning when we deprive ourselves of food in order to be more open to prayer, to the needs of others, and to save money to give to the poor. Current Church discipline permits one to take a main and two lesser meals which do not equal the main meal. **Mandatory fast days are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, on which days one must abstain from meat and eat only one main meal. Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence and meat may not be taken on these days. The law of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 and older; the law of fasting binds those from 18 to 59 years of age.** Parents are reminded of their duty to introduce children gradually to the understanding and practice of penance. Adult example will be the greatest influence in this matter.

“Si compie oggi, in tutte le comunità parrocchiali, un gesto austero e simbolico: l'imposizione delle ceneri, e questo rito viene accompagnato da due pregnanti formule, che costituiscono un pressante appello a riconoscersi peccatori e a ritornare a Dio. La prima formula dice: "Ricordati che sei polvere e in polvere ritornerai" (cfr Gn 3,19). Queste parole, tratte dal libro della Genesi, evocano la condizione umana posta sotto il segno della caducità e del limite, e intendono spingerci a riporre ogni speranza soltanto in Dio. La seconda formula si rifà alle parole pronunciate da Gesù all'inizio del suo ministero itinerante: "Convertitevi e credete al Vangelo" (Mc 1,15). E' un invito a porre come fondamento del rinnovamento personale e comunitario l'adesione ferma e fiduciosa al Vangelo. La vita del cristiano è vita di fede, fondata sulla Parola di Dio e da essa nutrita. Nelle prove della vita e in ogni tentazione il segreto della vittoria sta nel dare ascolto alla Parola di verità e nel rifiutare con decisione la menzogna e il male. Questo è il vero e centrale programma del tempo della Quaresima: ascoltare la parola di verità, vivere, parlare e fare la verità, rifiutare la menzogna che avvelena l'umanità ed è la porta di tutti i mali. Urge pertanto riascoltare, in questi quaranta giorni, il Vangelo, la parola del Signore, parola di verità, perché in ogni cristiano, in ognuno di noi, si rafforzi la coscienza della verità a lui donata, a noi donata, perché la viva e se ne faccia testimone. La Quaresima a questo ci stimola, a lasciar penetrare la nostra vita dalla parola di Dio e a conoscere così la verità fondamentale: chi siamo, da dove veniamo, dove dobbiamo andare, qual è la strada da prendere nella vita. E così il periodo della Quaresima ci offre un percorso ascetico e liturgico che, mentre ci aiuta ad aprire gli occhi sulla nostra debolezza, ci fa aprire il cuore all'amore misericordioso di Cristo. Il cammino quaresimale, avvicinandoci a Dio, ci permette di guardare con occhi nuovi ai fratelli ed alle loro necessità. Chi comincia a vedere Dio, a guardare il volto di Cristo, vede con gli altri occhi anche il fratello, scopre il fratello, il suo bene, il suo male, le sue necessità. Per questo la Quaresima, come ascolto della verità, è momento favorevole per convertirsi all'amore, perché la verità profonda, la verità di Dio è nello stesso tempo amore. Convertendosi alla verità di Dio, ci dobbiamo necessariamente convertire all'amore. (Benedetto XVI, Mercoledì delle Ceneri 2006)”
