“Come la Parola vuole che siano i cristiani, quali discepoli del Cristo: modellati solo su ciò che vedono in lui o che da lui odono. Come luce del mondo, in modo da non ammettere il male e da illuminare coloro che ad essi si accostano affinché conoscano la verità, e divengano ciò che devono essere o mostrino ciò che sono. Come sale in terra, cosicché quanti hanno comunione con loro siano rinnovati nello spirito per diventare incorruttibili (S. Basilio il Grande, *Moralia* 80,1.9s).”

“*Risplendano le vostre opere davanti agli uomini, perché vedano le buone azioni vostre e glorifichino il Padre vostro che è nei cieli* (Mt 5,16). Non dunque “perché siate visti da loro”, con l’intenzione di convertirli a voi, perché se siete qualcosa non lo siete da voi; ma “perché glorifichino il Padre vostro che è nei cieli”, convertendosi al quale diventino quello che voi siete (Agostino, *La città di Dio*, 5,13-16).”

“I lontani non si possono interessare con una preghiera che non diviene carità, con una processione che non aiuta a portare le croci dell’ora. Senza volerlo li spingiamo sulle strade di una carità senza Dio e di una attività sociale senza preghiera. Un cristiano che si rassegnasse ad assistere indifferente alla rovina del mondo, rifiuterebbe la propria vocazione temporale, che è una vocazione di civiltà, e tradirebbe il Vangelo, traducendo il soprannaturale in accidioso quietismo. (...) Noi non ci crediamo dispensati dal lavorare con responsabilità nostra, né ci rifiutiamo di camminare con chiunque ha rettitudine di intenti e di opere. È finito il tempo di fare da spettatore sotto il pretesto che si è onesti e cristiani. Troppi ancora hanno le mani pulite perché non hanno mai fatto niente. Un cristiano che non accetta il rischio di perdersi per mantenersi fedele a un impegno di salvezza, non è degno di impegnarsi col Cristo (P. Mazzolari, *Se tu resti con noi* pp. 42-4).”

“Che cosa sono queste buone opere che possono essere viste in questa luce? Non possono essere altro che le opere che Gesù stesso suscitò in loro (i discepoli ndr) quando li chiamò, quando li fece luce del mondo sotto la sua croce: essere poveri, miti, stranieri, apportatori di pace ed infine essere perseguitati e respinti, ed in tutto ciò una sola cosa: portare la croce di Gesù. La croce è la strana luce che risplende, e in questa sola tutte quelle buone opere dei discepoli possono essere viste. In tutto ciò, non è detto che Dio divenga visibile...Visibile diventa la croce e visibili diventano le opere della croce, visibili diventano la privazione e la rinuncia di quelli che sono chiamati beati. Ma nella luce di questa comunità non si può più lodare l'uomo, ma Dio solo (D. Bonhoeffer, *Sequela* pp. 99-100).”
