THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday., January 12th, St. Marguerite Bourgeoys, Religious. St. Marguerite was born in Troyes, France, on Good Friday, April 17, 1620. Marguerite arrived in Montreal in 1653 and is rightly considered cofoundress of Montreal. In 1658, she opened the first school in Montreal and also organized an extern Congregation, an innovation at that time. She died in Montreal on January 12, 1700. Her last generous act was to offer herself as a sacrifice of prayer for the return to health of a young Sister. On October 31, 1982, Pope John Paul II canonized her and gives the Canadian Church its first woman saint.

Saturday, January 17th, St. Anthony Abbot St. Anthony is considered to be the father of Monasticism. He was born in Egypt around the year 250. After the death of his parents, he distributed his property to the poor, and beginning a life of penance, withdrew into solitude. He attracted disciples and laboured on behalf of the Church. He died in 356.


