THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Tuesday, January 12th, St. Marguerite Bourgeoys, Religious. St. Marguerite was born in Troyes, France, on Good Friday, April 17, 1620. Marguerite arrived in Montreal in 1653 and is rightly considered co-foundress of Montreal. In 1658, she opened the first school in Montreal and also organized an extern Congregation, an innovation at that time. She died in Montreal on January 12, 1700. Her last generous act was to offer herself as a sacrifice of prayer for the return to health of a young Sister. On October 31, 1982, Pope John Paul II canonized her and gives the Canadian Church its first woman saint.

Egli pure, dopo che fu battezzato nel Giordano e comunicò alle acque il profumo della sua divinità, ne risalì, e lo Spirito santo discese personalmente su di lui, posandosi quale simile sul simile. Anche a voi, quando siete risaliti dalla piscina delle sacre fonti, fu conferito il crisma, il quale è figura di quello che unse Cristo, cioè lo Spirito santo. Come Cristo dopo il battesimo e dopo la discesa in lui dello Spirito santo, uscì nel deserto e sconfisse l'avversario, così anche voi, dopo il santo battesimo e la mistica unzione, scendete in lotta contro la potenza avversa e la debellate (Cirillo di Gerusalemme, *Catechesi battesimali*, 21).

Secondo il salmo i "venti" sono i messaggeri di Dio e le "fiamme" i suoi ministri; secondo Luca il fuoco inestinguibile brucerà la pula e lo Spirito Santo è la discesa di Dio dal cielo che si apre su Gesù; alito dello spirito e fuoco accompagnano il nostro cammino. Incontrando il nostro limite nel salire a Dio, Gesù apre il cielo per tirarcelo giù, perché non abbiamo più scuse, perché non cerchiamo più scorciatoie che prendono in giro Dio. La venuta di Dio nell'uomo attraverso il figlio Gesù ha il respiro di un progetto, l'invito ad una speranza, la proposta di un cammino "zelante", lasciandoci accogliere da lui come sua appartenenza. E questo vale per ognuno singolarmente e per la comunità del suo insieme, "un popolo puro", perché non ci si salva da soli. La via è tracciata, ma non è un'autostrada; è sobrietà, lucidità ed equilibrio, distacco e padronanza dei propri desideri; è giustizia, disposizione di amore verso gli altri, ricerca del bene altrui prima del proprio, fino al dono della vita per gli amici; è pietà, non quella che cerchiamo talvolta per la pigrizia di compiere delle scelte e di assumerci delle responsabilità, ma quella che si dona silenziosamente a chi accosta il nostro passaggio incerto, magari proprio nel momento in cui siamo provati e sofferenti e non ci sembra di avere nessuna compassione da poter dispensare, mentre in realtà abbiamo proprio la condivisione della fragilità di ciascuno (Diaconia dell'O.P.G.)
