Fino a quando tutti I suoi nemici non siano annientati - e l'ultimo nemico ad essere annientato sarà la morte (1 Co 15,26) - l'Agnello di Dio continua a prender su di il peccato per ciascun uomo che è nel mondo, fino a che il

peccato sia rimosso da tutto il mondo e il Salvatore possa consegnare al Padre un regno preparato, in grado di essere governato dal Padre (Origene, *Commento al Vangelo di Giovanni*).

Ecco l'Agnello di Dio che prende su di sè il peccato del mondo. Non disse: 'colui che prenderà su di sè, ma ancora non prende', e neppure: 'colui che ha preso prima, ma non prende più su di sè'. Questa operazione di prendere su di sè il peccato egli la compie per ciascun uomo che è nel mondo, fino a che il peccato non sia rimosso da tutto il mondo e il salvatore possa consegnare al Padre un Regno preparato, che è in grado cioè (in virtù dell'assenza di ogni peccato, anche minimo) di essere governato dal Padre come re e accogliere in se stesso, in tutto quanto se stesso, ciò che è di Dio. Si adempiranno allora le parole: Perchè Dio sia tutto in tutti (1Cor 15.28). (Origene, *Comm.a Gv 1.37*)

Nessuno toglie i peccati, se non lui...a cui nessun bene per l'uomo è impossibile nè alcun male dell'uomo è insanabile. Come ha rivelato l'apostolo Pietro, dicendo: Voi sapete che non a prezzo di cose corruttibili, come l'argento e l'oro, siete stati redenti dalla vostra vuota condotta ereditata dai vostri padri, ma con il sangue prezioso di Cristo, come di agnello senza difetto e senza macchia (1Pt 1.18-19)..., quando per noi ha versato il suo sangue sulla croce; quando nel mistero della sua santissima passione ognuno di noi è stato purificato dall'acqua del battesimo; e quando toglie i peccati del mondo lavandoci dai nostri peccati di ogni giorno nel suo sangue, ogni volta che sull'altare si ripete il memoriale della sua beata passione. (Floro di Lione, *De actione...* 90.

L'Agnello *predestinato prima della fondazione del mondo* (1Pt 1,20) rappresenta l'amore eterno di Dio per il mondo e il peso dei dolori che questo mondo gli costa; non dice in primo luogo la condizione posta da Dio perché Dio possa amarci un giorno, ma il prezzo che paga egli stesso affinché noi lo amiamo. Il simbolo dell'Agnello non esprime in primo luogo ciò che a noi può costare la nostra pasqua verso Dio, ma ciò attraverso cui Dio decide di passare per venire fino a noi. (...) Il simbolo dell'Agnello ha dunque anzitutto senso per Dio stesso. Prima di mostrarci a libro aperto l'amore che dobbiamo a Colui che tanto ci ama, Dio mostra e 'vede' egli stesso, nell'Agnello così predestinato, quell'abisso nel quale...intende impegnarsi per noi e con noi, e insieme vi scorge e mostra l'amore che ci porta (G. Martelet, *Libera risposta a uno scandalo* pp. 203-6).
