On July 8, 2013 Pope Francis celebrated Mass on the tiny Sicilian island of Lampedusa to commemorate thousands of migrants who have died crossing the sea from North Africa. The choice of Lampedusa for his first official trip outside Rome was highly symbolic for the Pope who said that 'the deaths of desperate people trying to reach a better life that had been like "a thorn in the heart.'

We are living in such a multicultural city, among people from all over the world who came to Canada for better life.

We are living in such a modern, big and diverse city so it is so easy to forget about those suffering immigrants because of the new reality which is not always a dream.

During his trip to Lampedusa Pope Francis said: 'We have become used to other people's suffering, it doesn't concern us, it doesn't interest us, it's none of our business!'

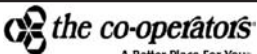
