Colei che veniva a me ha ricevuto la forza, poiché un segreto vigore m'ha sottratto//Perché, Simone figlio di Giovanni tu mi dici che un'immensa folla addosso mi si accalca? // la mia divinità essi non toccano, ma questa donna nella visibil veste // la natura mia divina ha conquistato in modo manifesto, e la salute ha avuto gridandomi: Salvami, Signore! // Donna, coraggio ormai che per la fede e col mio assenso tu mi hai spogliato. // Non opera di mia mano è questo, ma della fede tua; // Ecco perché davanti a tutti t'ho portato, per farti dire ancora: Salvami, Signore! (Romano il Melode, *Inni*, 33).

La fanciulla non è morta, ma dorme. Insegna a non temere la morte: essa non è più morte ma è diventata sonno. A quel tempo non era palese che la morte era divenuta un sonno, oggi invece questa verità è più chiara del sole. Cristo non ha risuscitato tua figlia? Ebbene, la risusciterà con assoluta certezza e con gloria più grande! Quella fanciulla, dopo essere stata risuscitata, più tardi morì di nuovo, ma tua figlia, quando risusciterà, rimarrà per sempre immortale. Nessuno dunque pianga più i morti, nessuno si disperì né rigetti così la vittoria di Cristo (Giovanni Crisostomo, *Commento al vangelo di Matteo*).

La fede non produce niente, chi produce la salvezza è Dio, ma la fede accoglie l'azione di Dio: noi con la fede semplicemente accogliamo la salvezza che Dio ci dona gratuitamente per amore, perché è innamorato, misteriosamente ma realmente innamorato dell'uomo. Cioè il contenuto della fede è essenzialmente l'amore di Dio, che in Gesù Cristo è contenuto e rivelato e messo a disposizione degli uomini perché di questo amore l'uomo possa vivere: Dio ha scelto di far vivere e tu accogli nella fede la scelta di Dio, tu dici di sì a quella vita che Dio ti dona, quindi dici di sì alla tua vita accogliendone da Dio la pienezza, la gioia e la ricchezza. Questo *perché chiunque crede in lui non muoia, ma abbia la vita eterna*. Credere in lui, vuole dire: accogliere Gesù di Nazaret come

rivelazione e ricchezza dell'amore di Dio per noi; vuole dire: lasciarsi amare da Dio attraverso Gesù di Nazaret. Non credere, rifiutarsi di credere, non è altro che rifiutare il dono della vita che viene da Dio. E quando l'uomo rifiuta la vita come dono di Dio, non ne ha un'altra di riserva, non ne ha una per conto suo (L. Monari, *Alle radici della missione*, 43-44).
