SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Wednesday, July 29th, St. Martha, disciple of our Lord. St. Martha was a sister of Mary and Lazarus. When she received our Lord as a guest at Bethany, she looked after Him with devoted attention. She begged our Lord to raise her brother, Lazarus from the dead.

Thursday, July 30th, St. Peter Chrysologus, Bishop, Doctor. St. Peter was born in 406. St. Peter was called "Chrysologus" (golden-worded) because of his exceptional sermons. He died in 450.

Friday, July 31st, St. Ignatius of Loyola, Priest. St. Ignatius was born in 1491 at Loyola, Spain. He spent his early years at court and as a soldier. He experienced a conversion which led to theological studies at Paris. There he attracted followers who became the first members of the Society of Jesus. Commonly known as Jesuits, they aided the renewal of the Church. St. Ignatius died in 1556.

Saturday, Aug. 1st, St. Alphonsus Ligouri, Bishop, Doctor. St. Alphonsus was born at Naples in 1696. Though renowned as a doctor in Canon and Civil law, he left the legal profession and entered the priesthood. Subsequently, he founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, commonly known as Redemptorists. He died in 1787.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION Cardinal Thomas Collins has decided to change the elementary school grade for the candidates for Confirmation from grade 8 to grade 7 for the Archdiocese of Toronto. This will take effect September 2015. In order for us to maintain simplicity and to prepare for this double cohort, we will keep our Confirmation celebrations at the same time, that is to say, close to the Solemnity of Pentecost, May 15, 2016. Confirmations will still be done per school with children attending schools outside our church boundary interspersed throughout the dates. More information will be distributed in September / October 2015 to the parents of Gr. 7 and Gr. 8 students.

Le diede loro gratuitamente, sebbene avessero potuto acquistarle da lui, affinché sapessero che non sarebbe stato loro richiesto il

pagamento di una cosa inestimabile. Ha nascosto la dolcezza nel vino da lui fatto, per indicare ai convitati quale tesoro magnifico è nascosto nel suo sangue vivificante. Sono sempre stupito di scoprire che quando mi sento molto vuoto all'interno di me, sono capace di dare una parola nutriente, o che essendo angosciato posso trasmettere la pace. 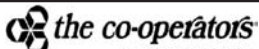
