**POPE FRANCIS' ENCYCLICAL: LAUDATO SI', ON CARE FOR OUR COMMON HOME**

On June 18, Pope Francis' encyclical "Laudato Si', On Care for Our Common Home" was formally released. Archbishop of Toronto, Cardinal Thomas Collins, commented on the teaching letter: "The central theme in this letter to all people of goodwill remains: 'What kind of world do you want to leave to those who come after us?' The encyclical reminds us that we have been entrusted with an abundance of gifts from God to nurture and use responsibly as good stewards. We are also reminded that our actions have ramifications, often impacting the most vulnerable in our society. We must never forget the marginalized among us. In the vast and diverse archdiocese in which we reside, there is much for us to consider and act upon. My prayer is that the reflections offered by Pope Francis through Laudato Si' will give us pause as we consider what each one of us can do, inspired by our faith, to care for creation and all those whom we encounter."

**SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION ANNOUNCEMENT**

Cardinal Thomas Collins has decided to change the elementary school grade for the candidates for Confirmation from grade 8 to grade 7 for the Archdiocese of Toronto. This will take effect September 2015. In order for us to maintain simplicity and to prepare for this double cohort, we will keep our Confirmation celebrations at the same time, that is to say, close to the Solemnity of Pentecost, May 15, 2016. Confirmations will still be done per school with children attending schools outside our church boundary interspersed throughout the dates. More information will be distributed in September / October 2015 to the parents of Gr. 7 and Gr. 8 students.

**ST. MICHAEL'S CATHEDRAL TEMPORARY CLOSURE**

St. Michael's Cathedral, mother church of the Archdiocese of Toronto, is temporarily closing its doors as part of its extensive restoration efforts that have been ongoing for the past three years. The next phase of restoration will require its closure full-time to allow for work that will preserve the cathedral for years to come. Daily Mass will continue to be celebrated in St. John's Chapel, a small worship space accessible from 200 Church Street. Nearby, St. Paul's Basilica will provide additional weekend Masses beginning in July, featuring music from St. Michael's Choir School to accommodate the cathedral closure. A timeline has been forecast as follows:

- June 17, 2015 – mid-December 2015 - full closure of St. Michael's Cathedral.
- Mid-December 2015 – January 2016 - cathedral will open briefly pre/post-Christmas.
- January 2016 – March 2016 - full closure of St. Michael's Cathedral.
- March 2016 – September 2016 - cathedral will open prior to Holy Week and Easter, remaining open while work continues through September 2016.
- September 29, 2016 – goal to complete this phase of restoration. This date is also the Feast of St. Michael, patron saint of the Archdiocese of Toronto

Fa' attenzione, infatti, a queste parole: *Non poté compiere alcun miracolo*; difatti non ha detto: *Non volle*, bensì: *Non poté*, perché si sovrappone al miracolo che sta per compiersi una collaborazione efficace proveniente dalla fede di colui su cui agisce il miracolo (Origene, *Commento al vangelo secondo Matteo*).

Una Chiesa disinteressata cerca soltanto l'onore del suo Signore e non il proprio, perché anche il Signore non ha mai cercato il proprio onore, bensì quello del Padre. Essa cerca nella Scrittura le parole che le insegnano l'obbedienza più completa. Nella sua liturgia non cerca la soddisfazione della comunità, bensì l'adorazione del suo Signore e l'investitura della sua forza per il proprio compito. Nei rapporti coi cristiani separati cerca di osservare il comandamento pressante del suo Maestro: unione come amore. Cerca nel mondo profano che le sta attorno la sua missione: essere lievito che agisce scomparendo (H.U. von Balthasar, *Chi è il cristiano?*, 257-258).

È importante l'incontro con la gente, l'ascolto, la compassione, tutto ciò che, alla fine, sintetizza la misericordia: **donare la libertà agli uomini attraverso la qualità del tuo ascolto e della tua attenzione**, proprio perché li fai sentire importanti, perché li ami, li rispetti, vuoi che raggiungano la libertà. E, passando per quella strada, diventerai un uomo, una donna di pace, creerai la pace. Tutto il mistero in cui si è chiamati a entrare è, in definitiva, l'aprire - movimento che si fa talvolta lentamente - il nostro cuore davanti all'altro. **L'accoglienza sta nel cuore della vita**; l'accoglienza sta nel cuore del mistero cristiano. Non possiamo essere discepoli di Gesù senza lasciare che i nostri cuori si aprano alla realtà così com'è, senza porsi in ascolto delle persone così come sono, nell'ascolto della loro sofferenza e dei loro doni." 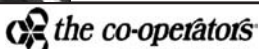
